THE INSIDER publishes records and intelligence on live POWs. You have subscribed as a way of keeping informed of the news and actions taken to find the missing Americans. We as a group sponsored "DOCTORS FOR PEACE" a group of U.S. Doctors who went to Vietnam to meet with over 800 Doctors in Hanoi in March 1995. On our behalf, these Doctors accomplished:

1. They were given/granted access to medical records on Americans who were treated by Vietnamese Doctors in military hospitals.
2. They set in motion a working plan to develop an anti-body to Dixon/Cancers, with Vietnamese help.
3. They were promised cooperations on POW/MIAs in exchange for their cooperation on possible medical treatments.
