30, 1994 a FOIA request was placed before the DPMO/DIA/OASD requesting a current list of DIA's database. On June 19, 1995 the DPMO printed a new copy: 36pages of it's database, covering reports received by DIA from April 30, 1992 to June 19, 1995. (The

DPMO forwarded this June 1995 list to the OASD on October 30, 1995 and the OASD forwarded the list to me on February 28, 1996, after 17 months (the wheels of progress turn slow, when it comes to live POWs, don't they?) From April 30, 1992 to June 19, 1995 (in 3 years & 2 months) DIA received 1316 additional "source reports," of which 183 were from "eye witness" providers who volunteered their observations. For a 3 year and 2 month period (April 1992 to June 1995) DIA had received an average of 34 reports per month from first and second hand sources on Americans missing in S.E. Asia (about 5, first hand, eye witness, live sighting reports, each month).

So in August 1981 there were 1204 "source reports" and by April 1992 there were 4287 "source reports" and by June 1995 there were 5603 "source reports". Look at the graph on page 5 for a view of this increase.

To review this raw data in a "finished intelligence" format one must factor out all reports evaluated to be fabrications or frauds, all reports of returnees both released alive and remains recovered, all reports where the source failed a polygraph, all reports of non-US Frenchmen, all reports of non-US Soviets, all non-US Eurasians, all members of the Lutheran church, all Afro-Asians, all mixed parentage, all nationalities not US, all former US detainees or Chi Hoa, all Mennonites, all vague rumors and all known scam cases or erroneous reports. To distill this DIA data down to only those "source reports" where the source give names, location and date of sighting of unaccounted or unknown individuals, and/or in cases where the DIA "correlated the sighting report" to a known case. By kicking all most all the reports off the plate that do not fit this diet or menu of criteria, one can see that

senator. DIA has correlated HSY-hearsay-second hand reports to PWs. Some key strokes by the input operator are entered wrong. In the database there are some during the war sightings that are correlated to PWs-some of these POWs returned, but some did not.plain

Cluster Map Now Available

Now you can have your own copy of the famous "Cluster Map" which reports on 928 sighting locations. This 11" by 17" color map was made with data taken from 16,000 source intelligence reports which have already filtered out all non prisoner or 'accounted-for' reports. All reports of Garwood, Kay, Gay, or Gougelman, as well as yachtsmen, smugglers, living freely, foreign nationals, dog tag reports, remains reports, and crash site reports have already been filtered out for you. The data is a picture of DIA's database with 928 live sighting prisoner reports, pinpointing their locations, current to April 8, 1992 sighting reports.

(238 reports between 1975 to 1992 and 14 reports between 1992 and 1995) provided by the CIA (the "D" under the position 6=report originator). The reason CIA reports are so important is that the "primary collector" is a controlled American source, an agent in place, who collected very, very valid on site data. The DIA database also contains only one report provided by the NSA (the "Q" under the position 6=report provider). The NSA report is as valid as they come, because they are from an intercept of enemy communications. One must question why the NSA has only provided the DIA with only one intercept after the Senate Select Committee final report was published-1993.

"High-level government commissions are usually meant to defuse crises and above all deflect political criticism from the White House or Congress. Seldom do they produce real solutions or lead to major reform, because that is not their true purpose," said David Wise author of "Nightmover: How Aldrich Ames Sold the CIA to the KGB for \$4.6 Million". In short the Senate Select Committee was a high-level government commission that did not have a management arm which stayed behind to oversee and follow-up what it found out.

The concept that the PWs were consolidated after the raid on Son Tay is not supported by these reports. Hanoi used PWs as human shields at locations they did not want bombed. The data used in this study is an exact copy of the DIA database. This sighting data does not rate the intelligence even through there is an established system. The POW puzzle of the REFNO's can be decoded by getting the senate select committee final report dated January 13, 1993, from your

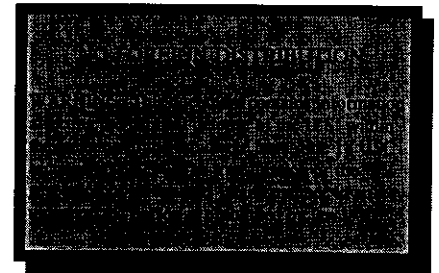
there is some very solid evidence that an unfortunate number of Americans were left behind alive. The current whereabouts and status of each individual has yet to be established and cannot be known, until there is a face to face meeting with these individuals. The following select source reports are presented to provide a view of the DIA database, but is not a complete study of valid or invalid data. In other words some data that is left out of the following report or review may be valid, but the criteria, to establish its independent verification is not given in the DIA database print out. For example, refer to the enclosed lists titled Morgan Donahue, REFNO 004, and Eugene DeBruin

In the cases of Morgan Donahue, the missing in REFNO 0004, and Eugene DeBruin, very clearly there are "source reports" where the primary collector, the source, the provider, gave these individuals name and/or picked their picture out of a photo album, which U.S. debriefers used to show eye witness who said they saw live Americans-thus the viewing can be pinpointed tentatively or positively to a missing POW/MIA. In some cases the raw data in the report allowed the DIA/DPMO to correlate the report to a specific individual based upon other previous reporting from all source intelligence or loss data (biographical data) or from other reports from the same or close area (geographical location) or from the similar time frame (date/time group).

The Library of Congress has a 400 page finder's guide to aid in researching 530 microfilm reels with over 17,000 files. To get a copy of the finders aid contact Dennis McNew at 202-707-3674. One can order the microfilm reels through Inter-Library loan, through you local Library (two at a time). One will find files on Morgan at the National Archives and in the Library of Congress microfilm collection (Reel 309 and 310). On microfilm are "source reports" 00000 to 18898.

As of March 12, 1992 the DPMO/DIA reported that only 46 first hand sources were given polygraph tests and 18 showed "no deception indicated" or passed the lie detector test. Now, as a non-official, unauthorized, unsanctioned investigator or viewer

of the DIA database, there are most likely more source reports that could pass a lie detector test, but they have not been pursued for this opportunity. When Col. Gains audited the DIA he said there was almost "gross negligence" if the follow up on live sighting reports. Gains/Perot/Tuttle AUDIT of DIA all reported the same mismanagement of "source reports". It is indeed a sad day when the people who are tasked to look for the POW/MIAs, don't do their job and get paid for it. The private sector review and exposure of this miss-management is most likely why deception books by Keating and McConnell got published, with inside



helpers who slipped them information and suggested the targeting of private individuals to be discredited. If the individuals who volunteer to serve in the U.S. armed forces only knew the kind of treatment they can expect to receive once they become captured or missing in enemy hands, they would refuse to take the risk. That is why it is so critically important to "insure confidence" in our troops that will go to fight in our future wars. There needs to be "a system" that will do everything humanly possible to secure the release of POWs, even in cases were "classified intelligence" has confirmed their captivity, but the enemy has denied holding them. Our current troops need the "solid assurance" that we will not leave them behind, alive, to be used as genetic pigs in chemical and biological human experiments, which is the Communist way. But, by looking at the intelligence history, specifically that of dealing with Vietnam POW/MIA cases, where vicariously tracking down leads

of live American prisoners, should have been pursued, the surface indication is that DIA failed to "vicariously track down the leads.

Another failure was in how the DIA/DPMO/JCRC/JTF-FA mismanaged a reward of \$2,000,000.00 that was put up for the return of a live POW. The reward was offered by private business men and individual Congressman, then announced and published widely. In 1988 DIA received its first report from a source who came in to claim the 2.4 million dollar reward:

Stoney Beach, JCRC, DIA and the JCS all decided to take the approach of telling the sources who asked about the reward, that "the U.S. government offered no such reward". The agents and debriefers were ordered to have selective memory and to deny that there was a reward, thus turning away sources who came to collect. This encyclical issued by DIA became a double standard as the U.S. in March 1996 put up a \$2,000,000.00 dollar reward for information leading to the recapture of a Palestinian hijacker of the Achille Lauro, hijacked in 1985, in which Leon Klinghoffer, a wheel chair American tourist was shot and dumped over board. So, for a criminal named Magied al-Molqi the U.S. government is willing "officially" to pay anyone \$2 million dollars who helps capture this bad guy, but the U.S. government is unwilling to pay anyone \$2 million dollars who helps captured POWs escape. Magied al-Molqi has been recaptured, but live POWs have not. With its conventional wisdom, DIA has kept the live POWs in a low profile moe using a repressive apparatus.

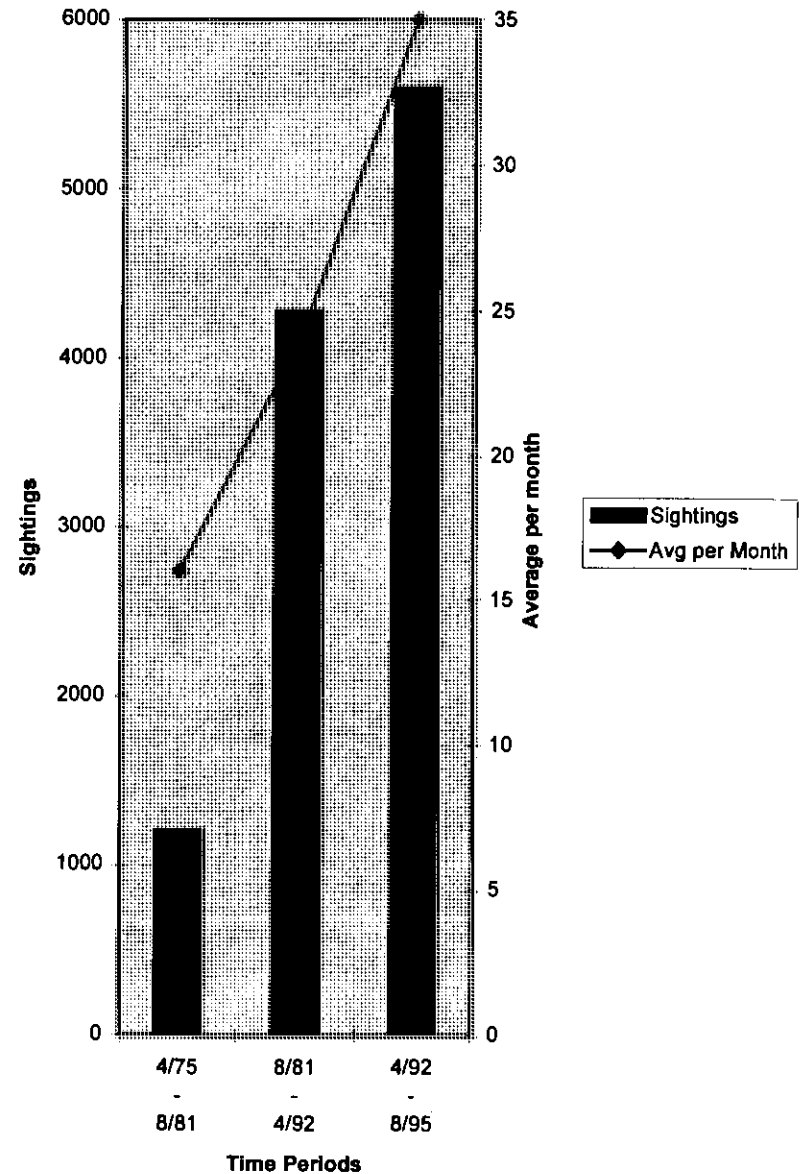

The enclosed list of live sighting reports and evaluations produced by Joint Task Force-Full Accounting (JTF-FA) from 30 April 1992 through 19 June 1995 is provided in response to your letter of 7 March 96.

JTF-FA obtains live sighting information from individuals in Thailand, Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia who contact our detachments and voluntarily provide information by letter or during an interview. A report containing the circumstances of the sighting is produced and sent via message from the detachments in Bangkok, Vientiane, and Phnom Penh to JTF-FA headquarters and simultaneously to Defense Prisoner of War/Missing in Action Office (DPMO). Reports from Hanoi are faxed to JTF-FA and then forwarded via message to DPMO for their action. JTF-FA analyzes JTF-FA produced live sighting reports and forwards the evaluations to DPMO for further action. DPMO is the U.S. Government agency responsible for analysis, evaluation, and adjudication of all live sighting information.

Thank you for your concern in this matter.

The above reports are but a sample of DIAs database but they point up several points. One-individuals are reported captured by reliable sources, who are believed to be good witnesses and these POWs were never accounted for. Two-some data is very, very current to the point that a reasonable and logical person would want to go to these reported locations and spend a week or two questioning the local population about, what they saw and what they knew. Three-there are many, reports of live POWs that are in the late 1970s, several in the early and late 1980s and some in the 1990s, but well after the Vietnam War ended. These reports most assuredly give the exact location at which point the sighting took place, so these reports need to be checked out. Where there are photos of captured Americans, who are alive in the picture, these live individuals need to be accounted for.

There are reports in the 1990's (**) that should be or should have already been investigated, on the ground, at the sighting location, to verify, confirm or deny the veracity of the report. Some, immediate action drill, by a CAS team, should have taken place to resolved named & current cases.

One could investigate the source, the provider, by polygraph tests, by trying to trip them up with trick questions or by checking the DIA database to see if the source reporter/provider was giving an accurate description of areas that we already know the answers to. But, all these steps will not provide on ground, line of sight verification. DIA in the past, while attempting to shake the source from

don't want to get their hands dirty. The "live POWs" symbolizes failure in our system, that is said to be perfect or at least a lot better than other government systems around the world. So, justify this premise!

Attached on 5 pages are the live sighting reports the JTF-FA has received from June 1992 to November 1994 kept in a file called "LIVE.XLS" of 100 live sighting reports. What happened to reports from December 1994 to May 1996? Are they all still classified or still under investigation? Are they sitting on someones desk in Washington, DC at the DPMO? What is the story? Review this list for accuracy.

The DPMO database of live sighting reports dated June 19, 1995 shows 1316 reports received since April 30, 1992. "A substantial growth in POW information" is not put in the newspapers, because the newspapers have been told that there is no valid or verifiable current information being received, thus the newspaper editors have a "told" political bias. Their government sources would not lie to them, would they?

I hope and pray that the following facts will open the eyes of those, who only have an ear for what they are "told" is the truth, by government sources who request anonymity.

The CIA who is spying in Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia collected these reports from April 1992 to June 1995:

What is important about CIA "originated reports" is that they are collected by the covert action staff (CAS agents) in the field, where spies, informants, controlled sources and valid field data is collected from human sources by human sources. These are not vague, casual or occasional observations, as the data is collected directly from the original source. A CIA report is pretty solid stuff. You cannot get into Langley, past the gate, without a pass so these sources did not stop by one day in Virginia to drop off their information. I know-I have been inside the CIA at the Langley Office and before you are escorted in you have to

be in their computers, approved to enter, given a pass and taken to your meeting room. The data collected by the CIA is a guarded secret. So, reports provided to the DPMO by the CIA, however presented by the DPMO, are very valid reports.

So, who's job is it to verify these reports, go to where the POWs are reported and validate or invalidate the reports? If the records are very, very clear they would show who was sent and what they found, but the records get very vague at this point. No one says it is my responsibility to check it out and I did it. All "real" investigations are conducted in secret, the results are secret and the reports are all classified on who did it and how it was done. The only reports that are "publicly discussed" are the ones that "failed to confirm". It is very hard to deny this one fact-- verification methods are classified.

The DPMO has taken a "new approach" to live sighting reports by only seeking to evaluate, analyze, compare to their database FIRST HAND reports where there are "CAPTIVE" or "LIVING FREELY" reports. Using this criteria the DIA/DPMO has labled all first hand reports as returnees, fabrications, not US POWs, Garwood, HEARSAY-F/H, Gay/Lecornec, Gougelman, McKinney, Struharik, H. McDonald or Eisenbraun. But, the following reports are examples that they relate to some individuals who were not accounted for as a function of DIAs own review of the information in the report.
