


NAVAL DEFENCE ACT 1910 - 1968.
NAVY (BOARD OF INQUIRY) REGULATIONS.
REGULATIONS 3, 4, 5 AND 13.
CONVENING OF BOARD OF INQUIRY.

DECLASSIFIED

1. In pursuance of regulation 3 of the Navy (Board of Inquiry) Regulations, the Naval Board HEREBY CONVENES a Board of Inquiry to inquire into all the circumstances surrounding the collision between the ship of the Royal Australian Navy "Melbourne" and the ship of the Navy of the United States of America "Frank E. Evans" on the third day of June 1969.
2. In pursuance of regulation 3 of the Navy (Board of Inquiry) Regulations the Naval Board HEREBY DIRECTS the Board of Inquiry to inquire into all the facts and circumstances connected with the collision and in pursuance of regulation 5 of those Regulations HEREBY REQUIRES the Board of Inquiry to submit its findings of facts and opinions in duplicate original reports to the Commander of the Seventh Fleet of the United States of America and to the Naval Board.
3. In pursuance of regulation 4 of the Navy (Board of Inquiry) Regulations the Naval Board HEREBY APPOINTS the following persons to compose the Board of Inquiry, namely:
