


THE DATA: THONGVANG SOUMNARATH, 27

OBJ DATA: Crash site, Death of Pilots, Gravesite/second hand account.

NGS: Review of data supplied by the source reveals a probable correlation to REFNO 0606.

LATE DATA: REFNO 0606 concerns the loss on 4 March 1967 of MAJ Ralph L. Carlock, USAF, pilot of a F105D on an Armed Reconnaissance Mission over Laos. While preparing to engage the enemy, his aircraft was hit by enemy fire, started to burn, and crashed vicinity of UG950544. The flight leader called MAJ Carlock, told him he was on fire, and twice told him to bail out, but received no acknowledgement. MAJ Carlock is currently carried in the status of Dead, Body covered.

ROUND/COMMENTS: The location and type of aircraft, as relayed by source, matches reasonably well with REFNO 0606. Source's sketch indicates that the gravesite containing the pilots is located vicinity of UG938559.
