

REFUGEE REPORT & EVALUATION


SOURCE DATA: NGUYEN HUU TRACH, 51  
REFUGEE REPORT INTERVIEW NR & DATE: HK84-090, 21 September 1984.

CATEGORY DATA: Remains Identification Media Data, Crash site/third hand account - Crash site/  
second hand account.

FINDINGS: Review of data supplied by the source reveals a potential correlation to REFNO 0856.

CORRELATE DATA: REFNO 0856 concerns the loss on 8 October 1967 of LTJG Andrew G. Zissu,  
LTJG Donald F. Wolfe, LTJG Norman L. Roggow, ATC Roland R. Pineau and JOSN Raul A. Guerra.  
They were aboard an E1B inbound to Da Nang when the aircraft crashed in the vicinity of  
BT875905. The crash site was in hazardous terrain (3700 foot level of a mountain slope) that  
precluded a helicopter landing or sending a ground party to the site. All personnel are carried  
in the status of Dead-Body Not Recovered.

BACKGROUND/COMMENTS: Identification Media Data pertaining on French, D. F. and Hagewood,  
Paul D., cannot be correlated as they are not listed as unaccounted-for. Both names have been  
reported before. The hearsay aircraft crash near Binh Giang aka Binh Trung (V) (BT1846) pro-  
bably correlates to a USA UH-1 helicopter tail number 66-16260, that was lost on 15 November  
1969 at BT179466, as listed in All Loss Records. Remains that were believed by the source to  
have been removed from the crash cannot be correlated. However, the crew status of the UH-1  
indicates that two personnel are listed as KIA and two as rescued. The crash site that was  
relayed to source from his nephew potentially correlates to REFNO 0856, based on location data  
provided.
