CF OTHER INMATES WERE TAKEN TO AN AIRCRAFT CRASH SITE  
 TO RECOVER METAL FOR USE IN MAKING BUCKETS. SOURCE  
 RECOGNIZED THE AIRCRAFT TYPE/DESIGNATION AS AN L-19.  
 THIS AIRCRAFT WAS LOCATED IN KATUM DISTRICT, TAY NINH  
 PROVINCE, NEAR THE VIETNAMESE/CAMBODIAN BORDER.  
 LOCATED ABOUT FORTY METERS FROM THE AIRCRAFT, SOURCE  
 FOUND A SINGLE MILITARY COMBAT BOOT FOR THE RIGHT  
 FOOT. THE BOOT WAS A COMBINATION CANVASS/LEATHER  
 FOOT. THIS BOOT HAD ONE DOG TAG TIED TO THE SHOELACE  
 AND A SLIT ALONG ONE SIDE OF THE BOOT. SOURCE STATED  
 IT APPEARED TO HIM THE PILOT HAD BEEN WOUNDED IN THE  
 FOOT AND SLIT THE BOOT TO GET IT OFF. HIS SEARCH OF  
 THE AREA DID NOT REVEAL EVIDENCE OF ANY REMAINS.

COMMENTS: FIELD COMMENTS - SOURCE STATED HE LOST THE  
 DOG TAG AND CAN ONLY REMEMBER THE RELIGIOUS PREFERENCE  
 WHICH WAS CATHOLIC.
