SUMMARY: THIS IS A STONY BEACH REPORT. IT PROVIDES
HISTORICAL INFORMATION REGARDING AIRCRAFT SHOOTDOWNS,
PILOT DEATHS AND PILOT CAPTURES AND SRV UNITS WHO ARE
CREDITED WITH THE KILLS.

TEXT:

1. THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION WAS EXTRACTED FROM A

PEOPLES ARMY OF VIETNAM PUBLISHING HOUSE BOOK ENTITLED
"PHONG KHONG KHONG QUAN" (AIR FORCE AIR DEFENSE). THE
BOOK WAS PUBLISHED IN VIETNAMESE IN 1978 AND WAS
AUTHORED BY NGUYEN DUONG (NGUYENX ZWONG), VU THANH
(VUX THANH), HA BINH NGUONG (HAY BINH NHONGX), TRAN
KY (TRANG KY), HONG NIEM (HOONGI NIEMJ), AND XUAN
MAI (XUAN MAI). THE BOOK CONSISTS OF 516 PAGES AND
WAS PRINTED BY THE MILITARY PRINTING HOUSE: 21,200
COPIES PRINTED. IT IS UNCLASSIFIED AND WAS PURCHASED
OPENLY IN HANOI. IT WAS TRANSLATED BY A PART-TIME
LOCAL HIRE RESEARCHER/TRANSLATOR UNDER CONTRACT TO THE
US OFFICE FOR POW/MIA AFFAIRS IN HANOI.

2. ON 5 AUGUST 1964, A FLIGHT OF SIX AIRCRAFT WAS
FLYING IN COLUMN FORMATION ALONG THE COAST AS A
DIVERSIONARY TACTIC FOR TWO OTHER FLIGHTS WHICH WERE
ATTACKING THE AREA OF LACH TRUONG. AFTER 30 MINUTES
OF FIGHTING (APPROX 1440 HOURS), LACH TRUONG FORCES
SHOT DOWN TWO US ACFT, KILLING TWO PILOTS. VILLAGERS
OF NGU LOC (NGUN LOOCJ) VILLAGE FISHED ONE OUT OF THE
WATER WITH FISHING NETS. THE PILOT, WHO WAS FROM
CALIFORNIA, WAS NAMED "RI-SA SE-TRO" (NO COMMENT:
RICHARD SATHER, REFNO 0034-0-21) AND HAD BEEN FLYING
AT 2000 FT ALTITUDE.

3. ON 5 AUGUST 1964, TWO AIRCRAFT PILOTTED BY ALVAREZ
(NO COMMENT: REFNO 0035) AND ALEXANDER, ATTACKED THE
AREA OF BAI CHAY (BAI CHAYS). ALEXANDER, FLYING A
SKYHAWK, TOOK THE LEAD. THE LEAD AIRCRAFT DROVE FROM
3000M ALTITUDE, DROPPED ALL THE 70MM ROCKETS, AND
THEN TURNED BACK TO THE SEA. ALVAREZ OBSERVED SOME
SPARKS OF FIRE ON THE GROUND AND SOME SMOKE COLUMNS IN
THE AIR. HE TOOK A 30 DEGREE ANGLE, DROVE AND DROPPED
ALL THE ROCKETS AND THEN FLEW TO HA TU TO EVADE. WHEN
HE REALIZED THAT HIS PLANE WAS HIT, HE EJECTED. HIS
SKYHAWK, COVERED WITH BLACK SMOKE, PLUNGED INTO THE
SEA. ALVAREZ, WHO HAS 26 YOA AND HAD BEEN MARRIED FOR
ONLY SIX MONTHS, WAS CAPTURED BY FISHERMAN AND HANDED
OVER TO A NEARBY NAVAL VESSSEL.

4. THE BATTLE AT VINH ENDED AT 1705 HRS ON 5 AUG 64.
GENERAL BQ ANNOUNCED THAT ON THAT DAY, THE VIETNAMESE
SHOT DOWN EIGHT AIRCRAFT, DAMAGED THREE OTHERS, AND
CAPTURED ONE PILOT (ALVAREZ). THE EIGHT THAT WERE
SHOT DOWN INCLUDED: ONE 25 KM TO THE NORTHEAST OF CUA

HOI (CUWAR HOIJ); ONE IN THE HA TU (HAF TU) AREA OF QUANG NINH; ONE AT CUR GIUA (CUWAR GIUWAX) IN QUANG NINH; TWO AT LACH TRUONG (LACHJ TRWONGF) IN THANH HOA; ONE IN THE AREA OF HUONG SON (HWONG SOWN), HA TINH; ONE 20 KM NORTHEAST OF LY HOA (LYS HOA) IN QUANG BINH; AND ONE AT THE MOUTH OF THE DAY (DAYS) RIVER IN NINH BINH.

5. AT 1355 HRS ON 7 FEB 65, AN A4D AIRCRAFT WAS SHOT DOWN BY THE 14.5MM GUN OF THE 12TH RADAR COMPANY ALONG WITH ASSISTANCE FROM GUNNEBS OF BAO NINH (BAOR NINH) AND NGU TBUY (NGUW THUYR) COMMUNES. THIS OCCURRED NEAR THE MOUTH OF THE NHAT LE (NHAATJ LEEJ) RIVER IN THE AREA OF DONG HOI (DOONGF HOWIS). THE AIRCRAFT SWAYED AND PLUNGED HEADFIRST INTO THE SEA.

6. ON THE MORNING OF 11 FEB 65, COMPANY 2 OF THE TRUONG SON GROUP SHOT DOWN AN F8 ACFT AS IF FLEW INLAND FROM THE SPA IN THE AREA OF DONG HOI. THE PLANE WAS MARKED 403 AND WAS THE AIRCRAFT FLOWN BY MAJOR SHOYMAKER WHO PARACHUTED OUT AND WAS CAPTURED BY RESIDENTS OF THE LY NINH (LYS NINH) AND THUAN TRANG (THUAANS TRANG) VILLAGES, AND BY WORKERS AT THE BAC NAM (BACNS NAM) BRICK FACTORY.

7. AT ON 22 MAR 65, THE 37TH AAA BATTALION LEFT VINH FOR HA TINH. AT 1400 HOURS ON 23 MAR, THE 83RD COMPANY WAS FIRST TO CROSS THE BON FERRY. THE COMPANY COMMANDER AND TWO SQUADS BEGAN WORKING THEIR WAY ALONG DYO NGANG WHEN THEY WERE ATTACKED BY ENEMY AIRCRAFT WHICH WERE APPROACHING FROM THE SEA. THE UNIT FIRED ON THE AIRCRAFT AND ONE F8-U CAUGHT FIRE AND CRASHED INTO THE SEA. DURING THE NIGHT OF 23 MAR 65, THE 83RD COMPANY REACHED KY ANH. THE NEXT DAY, COMPANY 82 AND THE 14.5MM GUN PLATOON SHOT DOWN AN F-105 AS THEY CROSSED THE GIANG RIVER.

8. AT 1316 HOURS ON 26 MAR 65, ENEMY AIRCRAFT WERE ONLY 10 KM AWAY FROM THE RU NAI (RUS NAI) HILL IN THE AREA OF HA TINH. THE LEADING F-105 DIVED TO AN ALTITUDE OF 1520M WHICH WAS FLOWN BY LTC ROBINSON RISNER, THE COMMANDER OF 67TH SQUADRON OF THE 18TH TACTICAL GROUP. HE ORDERED THE AIRCRAFT TO ATTACK FALSE RADAR POSITIONS SET UP ON RU NAI HILL. MINUTES LATER, REPORTS STATED THAT TWO ENEMY AIRCRAFT WERE SHOT DOWN, ONE BY COMPANY 82 AND THE OTHER BY COMPANY 83. COMPANY 27'S POSITION HAS UNDER ATTACK, AND THE 82D AND 83RD COMPANIES SUPPORTED THE 27TH COMPANY. ONE F-105 WAS HIT AND IT CRASHED INTO THE SEA. THE PILOT, RISNER EJECTED, CALLED FOR HELP, AND WAS RESCUED.

9. ON 2 APRIL 65, CAPTAIN MORGAN (RO COMMENT: REFNO 0064) FLEW A RECON SORTIE ON THE HAM RONG BRIDGE. IN THE MORNING OF 3 APRIL, HE AGAIN FLEW INTO THE HAM RONG BRIDGE AREA TO RECONNOITER BY FIRE. AT 0930 HOURS, MORGAN'S AIRCRAFT, A "VOODOO" (RO COMMENT: RF-101), WAS HIT BY THE 37TH AAA COMPANY AND BURST INTO

FLAME AND CRASHED THREE KILOMETERS FROM TAO (TAOF) BRIDGE. CAPTAIN MORGAN WAS CAPTURED ALIVE. THE ENEMY FORCE CONSISTED OF 50 AIRCRAFT. LTC SNIDER'S FLIGHT OF 16 AIRCRAFT FLEW TO HAM RONG, BUT WERE REPELLED BY ANTI-AIRCRAFT FIRE. THE LEAD A4D AIRCRAFT WAS HIT AND CRASHED. THE PILOT, MAJOR VOHDEP, WAS CAPTURED IMMEDIATELY (RO COMMENT: REFNO 0066).

10. AT 1258 HOURS ON 3 APRIL, GENERAL MOORE PERSONALY LED A FLIGHT TO ATTACK THE HAM RONG BRIDGE. FLYING NORTHWEST OF THANH HOA, THE LEAD AIRCRAFT IN THE FLIGHT WAS SHOT DOWN. THE PILOT HAD NO TIME TO EJECT AND WAS FOUND DEAD IN THE COCKPIT. FOUR MINUTES LATER, A SECOND AIRCRAFT WAS HIT AND BURST INTO FLAMES.

11. ON 3 APRIL, SECTION A OF THE TAM DAO AIR DEFENSE GROUP WAS DISPATCHED FROM NGHE AN TO REINFORCE THE DEFENSE OF THE HAM RONG BRIDGE. AT 0920 HOURS ON 4 APRIL, WHILE CROSSING AT THE GHEP FERRY, FOUR A4D AIRCRAFT ATTACKED THE FERRY LANDING. THE ATTACKERS JETTISONED THEIR BOMBS AND FLEW OFF. ANOTHER FLIGHT ATTACKED FROM THE SOUTH. AFTER 30 MINUTES OF FIGHTING, WE SHOT DOWN THREE AIRCRAFT AND CAPTURED ONE

AMERICAN PILOT. BY AFTERNOON, THE TROOPS OF COMPANY 5 AND AN ELEMENT OF COMPANY 2 OF THE TAN LAO AAA GROUP, AND THE PEOPLE FROM THE BANKS OF THE YEN (YEN) RIVER TO THE TINH GIA (TINH GIA) DISTRICT SPAT, SHOT DOWN SEVEN ENEMY AIRCRAFT AND CAPTURED THE ONE AMERICAN PILOT.

12. WHILE THE TAN LAO GROUP WAS FIGHTING AT GHEP FERRY (4 APRIL), THE AAA UNIT OF THE AIR DEFENSE OFFICER TRAINING SCHOOL ARRIVED AT POANG MAI. THEY TOOK UP POSITIONS ON MAM XOI (MAAM XOOI) HILL AND WERE ATTACKED. THE 21ST COMPANY SHOT DOWN THREE A3J AIRCRAFT.

13. AT 0930 HOURS ON 4 APRIL, THE ENEMY CONTINUED TO ATTACK THE HAM RONG BRIDGE. AN F-105D, NUMBER 152, DIVED FROM 5000M ALTITUDE AND AT 1500M ALTITUDE, WAS HIT AND CRASHED TWO KM FROM THE BRIDGE. CAPTAIN SHAR, PILOTING AN F-105F, NBR 41, DIVED FROM 6000M ALTITUDE, DELIVERED HIS BOMBS AND FLED. CAPTAIN HARRIS (RO COMMENT: REFNO 0068) FOLLOWED HIM TO THE TARGET. HARRIS' AIRCRAFT WAS HIT AND HE HAD TO BALF OUT AND WAS CAPTURED AT 1130 HOURS.

14. IN THE SKIPS OF THE NORTHEASTERN AREA OF HAM RONG, MAJOR FRANK BECKSTEAD (PHOW-RAWNG BECS-XNETS) (RO COMMENT: NO REFNO) LED A FLIGHT OF FOUR AIRCRAFT. MIG PILOT TRAN HANH (TRANH HANH) OPENED FIRE AND SHOT DOWN MAJOR BECKSTEAD AND BOTH THE MAJOR AND HIS AIRCRAFT CRASHED INTO THE SPA. TWO OTHER MIG PILOTS, HUAN AND NGUYEN, SHOT DOWN JAMES MAGNUSON (RO COMMENT: 0069).

15. ON 24 JULY 1965, A FLIGHT OF AIRCRAFT CROSSED THE VIETNAM - LAO BORDER. WHEN THEY REACHED MOC CHAU, MOST OF THEM FLEW TOWARDS VIFI TRI AND SOME FOLLOWED THE DA RIVER. THEY FLEW INTO THE RANGE OF THE 63RD AND 64TH BATTALIONS AND AN F-4C WAS SHOT DOWN. REGIMENT 236 COMMANDER TRAN NHAN (TRANH NHAAN) SENT A MESSAGE TO THE HEADQUARTERS WHICH STATED, "AT 1553 HOURS ON 24 JULY 1965, THE 63RD AND 64TH BATTALIONS EACH FIRED TWO MISSILES. ONE F-4C WAS SHOT DOWN, ONE AMERICAN PILOT WAS CAPTURED AND ONE WAS KILLED. " FRIENDLY FORCES: PERSONNEL AND WEAPONS ALL SAFE. " SEVERAL HOURS AFTER THE SHOOT-DOWN, A COMMAND CAR OF THE 236 REGIMENT HAD GATHERED PARTS OF A WING AND EVIDENCE OF THE DOWNED PLANE AND THE CAPTURED PILOT. THE PILOT WAS RICHARD PAUL KEIRN (RO COMMENT: REFNO 0112-1-02) AND WAS THE COMMANDER OF A FLIGHT OF FOUR F-4C AIRCRAFT. (RO COMMENT: KEIRN WAS RELEASED FROM CAPTIVITY IN 1973, BUT HIS FELLOW PILOT, ROSCOE HENRY FOBAIR, REFNO 0112-0-01, IS STILL UNACCOUNTED-FOR.)

16. AT 1130 HOURS ON 26 JULY 1965, ONE BQM-34A DRONE AND ONE RF-101 CONDUCTED RECONNAISSANCE ACTIVITY OVER THE SON TAY AREA. AT 1226 HOURS, THE DRONE WAS SHOT DOWN. THE 64TH BN FIRED ON AND HIT THE RF-101. THE PILOT WAS FROM THE 13TH AIR RECONNAISSANCE GROUP AND

HE AND HIS AIRCRAFT IMPACTED WEST OF THE BA VI MOUNTAIN BEFORE HE WAS ABLE TO TAKE ANY RECONNAISSANCE PHOTOS. (RO COMMENT: POSSIBLY REFNO 0116.)

17. AT 1418 HOURS ON 27 JULY 1965, AN ATTACK WAS LED BY MAJOR LIELE (DI-DOW-LOW) INVOLVING TWO FLIGHTS OF F-105 AIRCRAFT (EIGHT PLANES). FLIGHT ONE, FROM TAKLI, ATTACKED FIRST AND CONSISTED OF CAPTAIN CONNELL (COCN-MEN) IN ACFT ONE, CPT BURGER (BOWOWS-GOW) IN ACFT TWO, CPT SPENCER (SPAGS-XOW) IN ACFT THREE, AND CPT KOSKO? (KEE-SOW) IN ACFT FOUR. AS THEY APPROACHED THE TARGET, LIELE ORDERED THE PILOTS TO MAINTAIN AN ALTITUDE OF 18 METERS AND FLY AT 900KM/HOUR. CAPTAIN CONNELL'S PLANE WAS HIT BY AA GUNS. HE DROPPED TWO NAPAIR BOMBS ON THE TARGET AND FLEW AWAY. CPT BURGER'S PLANE FOLLOWED, AND WAS DOWNED NEAR XAM (XAM) HAMLET AND HE WAS CAPTURED TEN MINUTES LATER (RO COMMENT: POSSIBLY REFNO 0115). WHEN THEY ATTACKED RADAR POSITIONS ON VO KHUY (VOO KHUY) AND YEN KY (YEN KY) HILLS, AN A-1E FROM THE ENEMY RESCUE TEAM WAS DOWNED NEAR THE DA RIVER.

18. AT 1450 HOURS ON 27 JUL 65 (SAME BATTLE AS PARA

16 ABOVE), OUR UNITS TO THE SOUTH SHOT DOWN AN F-105 FLOWN BY MAJOR DECKER? (DICHS-COW) WHICH CRASHED NEAR THANH SON. THE SECOND FLIGHT COMMANDED BY MAJOR PAUL CLEMENT? (POON COW-LI-NFN) TRIED TO KNOCK OUT THE FAISE RADAR SITE ON HILL 36. CAPTAIN PARKSON? (PCWOWCS-XEN) FLEW FROM BA VI AT AN ALTITUDE OF 20 METERS AND HIS F-105 WAS HIT BY AA GUNS AND CRASHED IN THE PHU SON (PHUS SOWN) AREA. PARKSON MADE IT OUT OF THE ACFT AND WAS CAPTURED BY THE LOCAL MILITIA.

19. ON 1 AUG 65, ROBERT DAUGBTREY (RO COMMENT: REFNO 0119) OF THE 12TH COMPANY, USAF GROUP 18, (LOCATED AT KORAT) WAS CAPTURED AT THE HAM RONG BRIGF.

20. ON 13 AUG 65, TWO A4 ACFT WERE SHOT DOWN IN THE AREA OF Y NA - XICH THO AREA CE NINH BINH PROVINCE. ONE F4 ACFT WAS SHOT DOWN AS IT ATTACKED FROM CHI NE. MILITIA UNITS OF THE SALT FLATS OF NAM HA SHOT DOWN AN A4 WITH SMALL ARMS, AND ONE A1-E WAS SHOT DOWN WHILE ENROUTE TO RESCUE ANOTHER. IT CRASHED INTO THE SEA. ALSO, A RECONNAISSANCE ACFT WAS SHOT DOWN BY THE FRONTLINE 2 GROUP.

21. ON 24 AUG 65, MISSILES OF THE D63 BATTALION SHOT DOWN TWO F4 ACFT. LTC FRANKF AND MAJ DORMUS (RO COMMENT: BOTH OF REF NO 0128) PARACHUTED OUT AND WERE CAPTURED.

22. ON 25 AUG 65, THE 64TH BN SHOT DOWN THREE F-105S.

23. ON 15 SEP 65, BCTH ITC ROBINSON RISNER AND MAJOR MORRIS RAYMOND WERE CAPTURED AFTER THEIR F-105 WAS SECT DOWN.

24. ON 20 SEP 65, MISSILE REGIMENT 238 SHOT DOWN ON A4-D NEAR HUU LUNG. PHAM NGOC LAN'S RED STAR AIR FORCE GROUP SQDRN SHOT DOWN ONE F4 IN HA BAC. A MILITIA UNIT AT DUONG HUU VILLAGE SHOT DOWN ONE A6 NEAR HOANH EO.

25. ON 5 OCT 65, THE 81ST MISSILE BN SHOT DOWN TWO F-105'S, THE AA GUNS SHOT DOWN ONE F-105, THE AA GUNS OF THE BACH DANG GROUP SHOT DOWN ONE F-105 AT CUA ONG, THE SELF-DEFENSE UNITS SHOT DOWN ONE F-105 IN THE BAI TU LONG AREA, WHILE ARMY UNITS SHOT DOWN TWO F-105'S, THE 83D MISSILE BN SHOT DOWN ONE F-105 IN THE LUC NGAN AREA, AND IN LANG SON PROVINCE, THREE ACFT WERE SHOT DOWN AND THREE PILOTS WERE CAPTURED.

26. ON 17 OCT 65, THE 82D MISSILE BN SHOT DOWN ONE F4-B, AND THE RADAR OPERATOR, LT KNUTSON (RO COMMENT: REFNO 0169) WAS CAPTURED. THE 82D BN ALSO SHOT DOWN TWO OTHER F4'S AND CAPTURED ANOTHER PILOT. FRONTLINE 3 GROUP SHOT DOWN ONE A4-E, AND THE AA GUNS AT HA BAC AND LANG SON PROVINCES SHOT DOWN FIVE ACFT, INCLUDING TWO ADDITIONAL ACFT WHICH WERE DISPATCHED TO RESCUE TWO WHICH HAD BEEN DOWNED.

27. ON 20 OCT 65, TWO JFT INTERCEPTORS WERE SHOT

IOWN.

28. ON 22 OCT 65, ONE F-105 WAS SHOT DOWN.

29. ON 23 OCT 65, TWO ACFT WERE SHOT DOWN BY MISSILES.

30. ON 31 OCT 65, 14 ACFT WERE SHOT DOWN.
