05-3591-70	<p><b>SUBJ:</b> (C) <u>Military Proselyting Activity Plan, Ba Ria - Long Khanh Province Party Committee, Region 7.</u></p> <p>(C) (10 pages, typewritten; B-3) Activity Plan, dated 30 Apr 70, signed by Vu Tam, ((possibly of Ba Ria - Long Khanh)) Province Military Proselyting Section, ((Region 7)), addressed to all subordinate agencies, provides instructions for the implementation of military proselyting activities in Apr, May, and Jun 70.</p> <p>This document provides a brief summary of the situation during the first three months of 1970 and states that following indoctrination on Directives 136 and 40/CTNT ((of COSVN)), the morale of cadre and troops had improved, and the people's hatred toward the enemy ((FVNAF/RVNAF)) had increased. Unfortunately, addressees did not take advantage of the favorable situation and failed to motivate friendly agencies and the local people to conduct repeated military proselyting operations. They also failed to develop military proselyting elements which have ((GVN)) legal status, and to teach their cadre how to proselyte enemy servicemen.</p> <p>Document states that in accordance with Directive 19, addressees should correct the cited weaknesses and consolidate military proselyting networks with more emphasis placed on the recruitment of ((RVNAF)) servicemen's dependents. Addressees should coordinate military proselyting activities with armed attacks and political struggles, and broaden the use of fifth-columnists to assassinate "tyrants" ((GVN officials)) and to wear down pacification, Popular, Self-Defense and Regional Force units. The primary objective for proselyting is ((RVNAF)) newly graduated officers. 
