

# SHAME ON THE UNITED STATES SENATE

THE ROLL CALL VOTE - January 27, 1994

62 senators voted YES on the Kerry-McCain Amendment urging President Clinton to lift the 19 year old trade embargo against Vietnam "expeditiously and-or immediately." The despots in Hanoi signed the Paris Peace Accords 21 years ago today. They have violated every one of those Accords. Hanoi kept behind hundreds of American POWs as hostages for war reparations we never paid.
