Dear Bill,

Thank you for sending the biography. I sent it off to the radio stations today. Please call me when you arrive in Danbury. I'll be teaching during the day and won't be in until about 4:30.

Directions to Danbury:

Take Interstate 84 in New York to Connecticut. Move to the left lane when you see the sign for Brookfield, New Milford around exit 5. This lane will bear left from I-84 and become the Route 7 Connector. Take the first exit off the connector, Federal Rd. At the bottom of the ramp, turn right. This will bring you to Rt. 7. [If you were to make a mistake and turn left off the ramp, you would still end up on Rt. 7, just farther north.] At the light at the end of the connector, turn left. The Days Inn will be on your right after the lanes merge. A room with two double beds was booked in your name for the 23rd and 24th.

Tuesday, May 24 WINE radio interview 8:00 A.M. at the studio

Plan to arrive at 7:30, give yourself 15-20 min. in case of traffic. 1004 Federal Rd. Brookfield 775-2255

Turn left as you leave the parking lot of the Days Inn onto Route 7 North. Turn right at the light, just before the I-84 overpass, to pick up the connector you were on last night. At the first light, turn right onto the Rt. 7 connector Brookfield - New Milford. Take it to the end and turn right onto Route 7 North. [You just bypassed all the rush hour traffic.] Continue north through the Four Corners in Brookfield. About 1 mile north of the light (Christopher's Restaurant and three gas stations) you'll see the sign for WINE on the left. Turn left into the driveway and parking lot.

I'll tune in on the way to work!

Tuesday, May 24 WLAD radio interview 1:00 - 2:00 P.M. at the studio

Plan to arrive at 12:45. Allow yourself 15-20 for driving and parking. 198 Main St. 744-4800

Turn right as you leave the parking lot of the Days Inn. Continue onto Rt. 7, past lots of car dealers, toward the center of town until Rt. 7 becomes Rt. 6, White St. You'll bear right onto White St. at the light rather than go left over the railroad trestle. Continue along White St. past the

down town campus of Western Connecticut State University.

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You'll pass by Litchfield and Newbury dorms, Old Main the administration building, Fairfield dorm, and White Hall. Ives Auditorium is in White Hall right in the front of the building. Continue as White St. bears right and comes up to Main St. At the light, turn left onto Main St. Continue through the next light and stay in the right lane. Just before the light at West St. you'll see a drive through area at Ives Manor (Senior Citizens Home), turn right in the drive and find a parking space in the back of the building. Go to the phone, I think it's right at the door, and dial 110. The radio station will let you in the building. Take the elevator to the 4th floor and follow the signs for WLAD & WDAQ.

Note: If you pass the library or Police Station, you're too far.

Al Bruhn from Comcast Cablevision is planning to attend the forum, tape it, interview you on camera, and use it during his weekly series, Connecticut News Talk. After it airs several times in the Danbury area, he sends it up New Milford Cable which reaches north into Litchfield County.

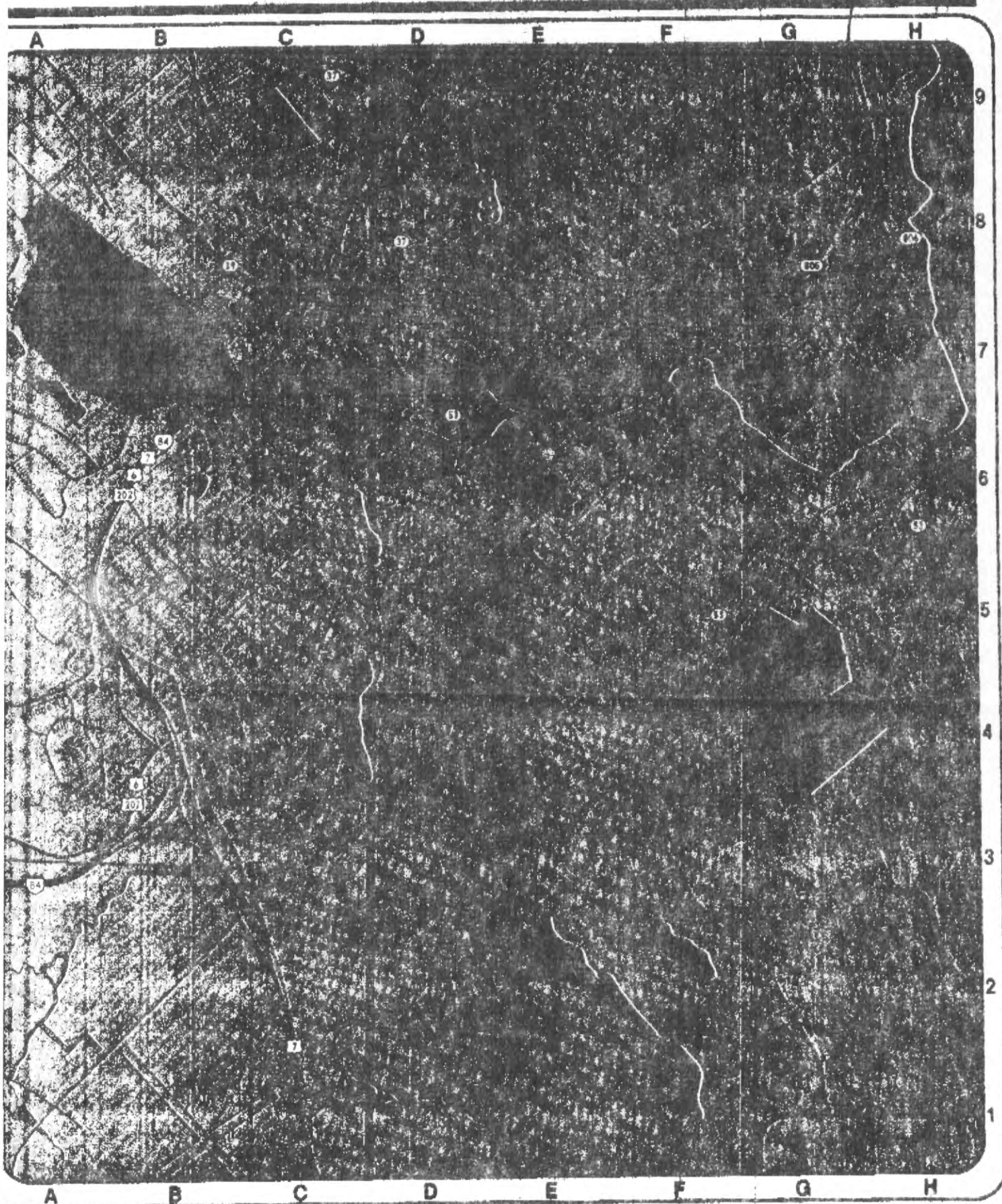
