Dear Senator Rudman:

The twelve Senators appointed to the Select Committee on POW/MIA are pursuing a secret and sinister agenda diametrically opposed to their mandate and have no intention of effecting a meaningful and accurate appraisal of the issue. Elements in the Executive Branch of Government have succeeded in compromising the mission and integrity of the committee through a combination of bribes and threats.

FORMAL CHARGES

In the official misconduct of affairs of this committee, I accuse its members, jointly and severally and individually of the following causes of action:

ACTIONS INCONSISTENT WITH THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES
ERRORS OF OMISSION AND COMMISSION
CONSORTING WITH KNOWN CRIMINALS
DEFRAUDING THE AMERICAN PEOPLE
BETRAYING LIVE AMERICAN PRISONERS OF WAR

Mistrust of Government is at an all-time high in America Today. The American people, the veterans and family members of POWs deserve better than what they are getting from the Senate Select Committee. There are forces driving this issue of immense magnitude that are not apparent to the majority of people. The oilfields in the Tonkin Gulf are so immense and the price so low that a company like Mobil Oil could, if it has not already done so, offer each senator a bribe of upwards to twenty million with a bump to the chairman of 50 million to make the POW Issue go away, and these bribes could easily be paid out of the first week of oil production.

There is a universal and total feeling of betrayal, distrust, abandonment and disillusionment in the POW Activist Community for the Senate Select Committee. There exists a total lack of confidence, the reasons for which will be stated below on an item by item basis. In view of this deplorable situation, it is incumbent on your position as Chairman of the Senate Ethics Committee, after making an investigation, to remove these twelve Senators, replace them with twelve others less likely to be compromised and then consider an alternate set of solutions. These are the three steps I recommend at this time:

STEP I: Removal of the twelve Senators and replacement with twelve others who are less likely to capitulate to sabotage and coercion. Their mandate would be for six months.

STEP II: Should this second Committee fail to perform staisfactorily, then it will be readily apparent to all concerned that due to enormous government interference, that an investigation and accurate appraisal of the POW/MIA issue is simply beyond the capability of the Senate. At this point, the only thing that will satisfy the POW Activist Community will be to appoint a special Federal Prosecutor and turn the investigation over to Amnesty International.

STEP III: Same as above, a special Prosecutor appointed who will work however under the aegis of the United Nations.

SPECIFIC ALLEGATIONS OF WRONGDOING AND IMPROPRIETY PERPETRATED

BY THE SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE ON POW/MIA

ITEM 1: When the committee was first formed, it had already been co-opted. High government officials gave the chairman a complete but rough draft of what they wanted the final report to say. The final is due in January, but its full, final and complete report was finished in August. Testimony now will only be slanted to fit the final conclusions. The whole process was a pre-arranged scam from day one.

ITEM 2: Amid much fanfare, the committee to "Find the final truth" and "Finally get to the bottom of the POW matter" was formed last January and was given one year and one million dollars and no prosecutor. At about the same time a committee was formed in the house to investigate 30 women getting their butts pinched at the Navy Pilots annual tailhook party. They got three million, a special prosecutor and no time limit. The hypocrisy of the U.S. Congress knows no bounds.

ITEM 3: A country used to rich and spicy hearings such as Watergate, Iran-Contra and the Thomas-Hill hearings, we are now given the dismal and disappointing array that finds people nodding off because if anything even smacks of progress, the chambers are hastily cleared for "Closed sessions". To show how totally bought off the committee is, even when they are presented with blatant prevarication and perjury, they sit there and sop it up. They bought an excuse from DIA that no prison exists under Ho's tomb because of the water table. Can a country with medical schools and computers not know how to build basements using seventeenth-century technology?

ITEM 4

The bogus trip to Vietnam. A trip was planned where we would technically have two hours notice for a "surprise" visit to a POW camp. It was common knowledge to activists that the camps selected had at least several weeks notice and from Vietnamese sources, I am now told it was more like months. Even then, they forgot to paint the walls and a Senator admitted seeing a drawing of a champagne bottle and "Happy New Year 1989". Vietnamese do not drink champagne and use the Chinese Year system. "Oh what a tangled web we weave when we set out to deceive".

ITEM 5

In the DIA analysis manual, there are 12 categories they sort out live sighting reports into (15,000 at last count). Of those, not one of the 12 is "Confirmed Live sighting report". The mindset is totally to debunk. The committee did not find it necessary to look into this matter and thinks the process is "Just fine".

ITEM 6

In one his first steps, Chairman Kerry had entered into the Congressional record a statement to the effect that "No threats, harassment or intimidation of POW activists and witnesses would be tolerated". Not only was this a hollow, meaningless promise, but now we find that the source of the threats is the committee itself as is the cover-up of the issue and the shredding of documents. Activists view the committee today the same as the DIA five years ago, only worse because Senators are more arrogant and likely to destroy evidence and shove people around. When a woman from Dallas who participated in the "Shut up and sit down speech" protest got fired from her job for daring to speak out for her relative, she went to Deborah deYoung on the committee with her problem. Not only was she not helped but her husband was threatened with being fired as well while the committee stood idly by, saying and doing nothing.

ITEM 7

Destruction of Evidence. Earlier this year former congressman Billy Hendon was fired by Committee Chairman John Kerry. Hendon said he was fired for not shredding documents when ordered to do so. Kerry said that the revelation of the documents would bring down the government. The POW Activist Movement unites in solidarity behind Billy Hendon. He has relentlessly pursued the issue for 13 years. No one seriously considers giving important documents to the committee anymore. They make a one-way trip to John Kerry's shredder. The community is compiling its own collection of documents. We have seen all too many occasions in the past where whistleblowers ARE NOT protected as required by law. They choose to leak documents anonymously instead. When the committee issues its final report, we will come forward with our own report refuting the committee's report for the fraud it is on a line item basis.

ITEM 8

The Committee is now the source of "Threats, harassment and Intimidation". They have been co-opted. When activists go to them, they are ignored. I filed complaints with five federal agencies for government interference and harassment during the Republican National Convention against our group. Total result-zero. The government and the committee are a united mission; Quash the POW Movement once and for all, at any cost. Two weeks ago an activist received a death threat at 2:30AM. We have advised all activists to have caller ID on their phone lines. The number traced back to a pay phone in the basement of the Clarendon Building, home of DIA. Staff members of the committee are in a perpetual adversary posture with activists and seem more intent on persecuting the "List of 19" than they are in finding out what happened to 2,267 POWs.

Item 9

There is a massive U.S. Government coverup of the POW/MIA Issue, has been for 23 years, and the Committee is doing more than anyone to perpetuate it. Recently leaked documents show a security classification none of has ever seen before. On the bottom of a document was a stamp that said, "By authority of Executive Order No. _____, this document is exempted for perpetuity from Freedom of Information Act and Privacy Act". This is on a POW document they never wanted anyone to see. It names names. The government has figured out ways to get around its own laws. At least in the year 2023 we will get to find out who really killed John Kennedy. Unless more patriots leak documents on POWs, 500 years will go by and the American People will still not know what happened to 2,267 POWs left to rot in Vietnam.

Item 10

What is driving this issue? Follow the money. We have not had any move in congress to normalize relations with North Korea in 40 years or Cuba in 30 years. Why now Vietnam? Two reasons; Oil and drugs, both abundant in great quantity in Vietnam. Another factor is slave labor and an absence of environmental protection laws. George Bush has been incessantly pursuing NAFTA ratification for free trade with Mexico. John Kerry has on several occasions said he favors immediate dropping of the trade embargo with Vietnam and giving them immediate Most favored nation status. An auto worker in detroit used to make \$37 an hour to do a job now done in maquiladoras in Laredo and Tijuana for 80¢ an hour and soon to be done in Hanoi for 5¢ an hour. Lane Kirkland with AFL/CIO predicts 3 million permanent job losses in the first two years of normalized trade with Vietnam. Any "trickle down" money made in these schemes goes only to megabankers, financiers and convicted felon swindlers like Boesky, Milliken and Keating. The larger picture here is to de-industrialize the United States for the enrichment of a very few close to the President.

Item 11

The Mobil Oil Connection. The current market price for oil is \$22 per barrel. Oil bought in the middle east for about half that allows them to only double their money. I was told by a Mobil official that they have in place a secret deal with Vietnam where they can buy it for \$2 a barrel with no environmental considerations whatsoever and anyone injured on a rig there would not be allowed to file a personal injury lawsuit. There is 800 million barrels of proven reserves. That's 160 billion in profits(not revenues)the first two years. Is the point clear? What business is Bush in? Would these people let a few POWs stand in the way of such immense profits? Would they bribe 12 senators if they felt it would make the POW issue go away?

In 1989, everyone thought Bush would be sure to be re-elected. Mobil started capping all oil wells on the North Slope of Alaska and plugging pipelines. The Valdez Oil spill was deliberate to convince U.S. Public opinion to stop all production of oil in Alaska and the ANWAR. We used to sell that oil to Japan to offset the balance of payments loss on imported cars and electronics, but profits come first. Mobil Oil owns the world-wide patents on jackup semi-submersible rigs needed to drill in the depth of water in the Tonkin Gulf Field. Only the U.S. Navy is strong enough to protect these rigs from China and Japan. George Bush and Mobil Oil were so cocksure of themselves that they assumed they could put this over easy on the congress and the American People. The Navy lease at Subic Bay was allowed to expire. There is a no-fly zone over Cam Ranh Bay today to hide some very interesting items; seven big Mobil Oil rigs and the floating Navy drydocks from Subic.

What are the long-range implications? The State of Alaska will go broke without oil revenue and its government will be on Federal welfare. In the last 15 years there have been 477,000 permanent job losses in the domestic Oil Industry; that's more than automaker and steel mill losses combined.(Bill Clinton has a plan to re-establish domestic drilling, Bush does not). When the Glomar Java Sea drilling ship went down in 1982 the rescued crew were added to POWs in camps in Vietnam. Once the Vietnamese have their own petroleum engineers, they are likely to "Nationalize" the oil rigs, just like Mexico did. We never learn. At least Mexico let the gringos go home; Vietnam will simply put all Mobil employees in bamboo cages with the Americans already there from the war 20 years ago. I hope Mobil Chairman Allen Murray is in Nam when nationalization occurs.

Item 12

Americans killing AMERICANS. The POW/MIA Issue has been a big thorn in the side of the government for a long time. They are desperate to make it go away un-noticed. Enormous egos and reputations will be ruined if all the truth came out. Satellite intelligence so sensitive it can count eyelashes on an eyelid has allowed the U.S. Government to know exactly who is in captivity and where they are. Several attempts, some successful, have been made to to "Terminate the merchandise". Scott Barnes claims he was ordered to do just that on the mission code named "Bohica". Harry Martin, in a copyrighted article in his Napa Sentinel alleged that CIA Langley HQ ordered American Prisoners near Hanoi moved to avoid being rescued by a private mission by Hatchet Jack and Raven Papa Fox. The message said if the men couldn't be moved in time to kill them.

It is common, but highly secret, that in combat, anytime you have your position about to be over run, you burn the code books and kill anyone who knows what's in them. This happened in Korea at Inchon; 200 Army Security Agency personnel were killed with BARS by their bodyguards from the 82nd Airborne just before the position was over run. In the case of the Pueblo, Captain Boucher's secret court martial was because he failed to blow up the ship and his men rather than let its secret equipment be captured. When a U.S. Navy nuclear submarine on a spy mission in Russian waters was forced to surface in Vladivostok harbor, the communications officer came in the room and told the four Russian Linguists and codebreakers if they were boarded, he would have to kill them and he threw down on them with his .45.

In the late 1980's there were four missions in Laos for the sole purpose of killing American POWs. Two missions were done by CIA with success. They parachuted in at night on HALO jumps, killed everyone in the camp and then radioed for pickup. Navy Seals did the other two. Bud Nance and Richard Armitage were involved. The missions were code named "POcketchange". Armitage owns a chain of brothels throughout Asia and got drunk one night and talked about them. The next night an entire Navy Seal team was wiped out to the last man as they landed in an ambush. All the members of the committee know the information I have just mentioned actually happened. Why don't you ask them about it?

Item 13

The SUPERSECRET National Reconnaissance Office. This agency is responsible for collection and analysis of all satellite and SR71 Mach 7 photos. The director is Martin Faga and his office is in the Pentagon, Room 4C958. His agency's budget is larger than the entire CIA and the Coast Guard combined. He knows more about the status of live American POWs than any man in the world. Why is it that this man and no one from his agency have appeared before the committee if their intention is to seek real answers?

When Bobby Garwood was debriefed by DIA he was shown over 500 pictures taken of him while he was in captivity. He was stunned by their clarity. They had literally kept a day-by-day vigil of his whereabouts and activities. It is reasonable to presume that other "Photo albums" of American POWs exist. In the 80's, an Israeli spy named Jonathan Pollard stole some photos of Yasir Arafats hideout in Libya and Israel used these photos to stage a raid. They were equally impressed with their sharpness, describing the intelligence quality of the photos as "Breathless".

In July of 1985, an SR71 Blackbird high altitude photo reconnaissance flight was flown over Laos. This was a DIA mission. The pilot was Brigadier General Joersz who had been sheepdipped into DIA. He returned with photos clear enough to offer positive ID of 50 American prisoners. One of the photo interpreters on the flight, an Air Force Lt. Col. due for retirement made remarks that he might go public with the information he was so upset about it. He disappeared. Six months later his girlfriend got a collect call at 3AM; he got off a few words; the call was traced to a pay phone at Talledega Prison near the HQ of Air Force Intelligence. The Air Force, by the way, has more information on POWs than any branch of the service and has cooperated the least of any of the Branches. Would you want your son flying over enemy territory tonight?

Item 14

THE ROLE OF THE CIA IN THE POW/MIA ISSUE. Unless you can accept the very basic fact that the CIA is and has always been the world's largest drug dealer then you can forget trying to figure out this issue or any other and go back to the nerd farm you came from. For the very few remaining people who don't believe this, I suggest you read the 635 page book, "The Politics of Heroin, CIA Complicity in the Global Drug Trade" by Alfred W. McCoy. It does not leave a single stone unturned. I would also suggest "Double Cross" by Chuck and Sam Giancana. It chronicles the intimate relationship of the Mafia and the CIA back to day one. Both books are in print and can be ordered from any bookstore in a shopping mall. All members of the committee are aware of what I am about to tell you.

The United States has 5% of the world's population and consumes 50% of the world's drugs. The profits are enormous and the amount of money spent on illegal drugs in one year could pay off the national debt. The Dulles-Jackson-Correa Report in 1947 tells how the military is supposed to assist the CIA on all missions and that the CIA "Should" pay for that help. Therein lies the problem. When congress (or anyone else) hands over money, they like to dictate how it should be spent. The Church committee of 1976 proved that. The CIA, by being in the drug business, generated its own money and had to account to no one. The war in Vietnam was originally fought to protect the CIA Heroin fields and labs in Laos. Only later was it expanded to enrich the military industrial complex and the pockets of Lyndon Johnson.

The CIA does not want the POW Issue resolved because it would expose and interrupt its drug lords in Laos. Also, in addition to the 2,267 military missing, there are at this moment 3,169 last seen alive in enemy hands who were contract agents or "Black Ops" military temporarily assigned to CIA. Remember, we were never legally allowed to have armed forces in Laos or Cambodia. The CIA planned and carried out the assassinations of John and Robert Kennedy, Martin Luther King, Marilyn Monroe, J. Edgar Hoover and 47 American POW Activists and troublemakers including Marian Shelton, Col. Nick Rowe, and journalist Ricky Cassolaro. As shown in the movie, "Apocalypse Now", CIA executions of troublesome American military and civilians in Vietnam during the war was a daily event. The Phoenix Project was not exclusively devoted to assassinations of Vietnamese.

What follows is a very basic chronology of extremely complex events that are still in progress. The stage and the props change with the years, but the actors remain the same. From 1957-1963, operational control of US Forces in Vietnam was directly by Saigon Chief of Station, CIA. John Kennedy signed NSAM 5507 transferring intelligence operations from CIA to Military Intelligence. He did this as retaliation for Bay of Pigs. 43 days later he was assassinated. Lyndon Johnson sent McNamara to Saigon to make a complete report and come home in two weeks. In what seems a standard U.S. Government practice (See Item 1) Johnson already had the report written and gave it to him before he got on the plane. This is very thoroughly documented in the book, "The Secret Team" by L. Fletcher Prouty.

An interesting group of men headed up CIA Proprietaries like Air America, etc. in Laos in the 60's and organized Hmong tribesmen to harvest opium crops. This group included Ted Shackley, Thomas Cline, Richard Secord, Oliver North, Ed Wilson, Bernie Houghton and Mike Hand. During this time the main bank used to launder money was Castle Bank and Trust in the Bahamas. When it folded, the NUGAN Hand Bank in Australia took up the slack. The mantle was later passed to BCCI. After Vietnam fell in 1975, these men concocted a plan called "Operation Haven" to relocate 3,000 Hmong tribesmen on the barren and uninhabited Turks and Caicos. These islands are in the flight path from Bogata to homestead and would be very convenient for refueling.

Iran-Contra came along and made enormous profits for the men above. Israel bellied up to the trough and has been there ever since. All the guns were bought from Israeli gun dealers at triple retail. For a complete rundown on this sorry event and what a crook Oliver North is, read "Hazardous Duty" by John Singlaub. Secord and North have been bosom buddies for many years. To presume they know nothing about POW/MIAs in Vietnam is ludicrous. For them to do nothing about it is treasonous. The same goes for the Senate Select Committee on POW/MIA

Item 15

THE ISRAELI CONNECTION TO THE POW/MIA ISSUE. This is an extremely murky area and only tangentially connected. It is important, however, in the larger context to understand their perspectives. The ability of Israel to manipulate congress and a succession of Presidents should never be underestimated. Israel had a series of wars in the late 60's and was furious that Lyndon Johnson had committed the entire US Military to a war far from the middle east. Israel was anxious to neutralize its enemies and expected American lives and taxpayer dollars to accomplish that. Our recent adventure in Iraq against Saddam Hussein is a perfect example.

In 1967, Israel attacked the USS Liberty. I knew personally many of the crewmen. While it was being attacked, the sixth fleet commander scrambled jets and rushed them to their aid. When Lyndon was told of the event, he very uncharacteristically backed down and ordered the Topgun jets to not fire and return to base. Johnson obviously owed some enormous debt to Israel. What was it?

Santos Trafficante, Mafia Caporegime for Tampa and St. Petersburg visited Saigon in 1968 with his consigliere and a large entourage. In 1970, Meyer Lansky, Mafia financier and believed to be the richest man in the world fled the United States to avoid having to testify before the US Senate. He was given assylum in Tel Aviv.

In the mid 80s, Noriega killed his predecessor and took over Panama. Drugs and money laundering banks were everywhere and so were agents of the Mossad, Israel's Intelligence Agency. Drugs from Peru and Colombia were flown in on CIA Planes and transferred to military planes for the final leg of the flight to Homestead AFB and the drugs then went through CIA operatives to the streets of New York, L.A., Dallas and elsewhere. A special forces unit was assigned to this effort called "Operation Watchtower". Those men are now all dead.

Israel had a very comfortable relationship with Noriega and George Bush. During Operation Just Cause, there were only 4 banks out of hundreds that were still open and moving funds by wire transfer to Europe and the Far East. They were all Israeli. Bush said no drugs were seized in the operation, but Soldier of Fortune magazine published a picture of US Army troops in a warehouse with what looked like an 800 kilo stash of .999 pure cocaine. All guns destined for the Contras originated in Israel and were transhipped from Panama. One can only presume what the cargo was on the return flight.

In the wake of Hurricane Andrew, Homestead was destroyed. It will remain open as it has for years to do you-know-what. A decision was made, however, to move the F 16 Squadron to McDill AFB near Tampa as gratuitous gesture of a grateful nation to the Trafficante Family for numerous services rendered over the years. As an interesting aside, Ross Perot purchased a damaged and very large shopping center directly across from Homestead AFB. What does he know that you don't?

Finally, we must talk about enormous egos among statesmen, generals and admirals. The Israeli raid on Entebbe to rescue Israeli Citizens from a hijacked ElAl airliner is a classic covert operation that has never been equalled before or since. The United States has no successes and two humiliating failures, one at Son Tay and the other to rescue the hostages at the American Embassy in Tehran. The Mossad contempt and disgust of the American CIA is so great that they will not allow CIA people to sit with them socially. The CIA has lost 98% of its ability to conduct clandestine missions and is now solely relying on satellite intelligence and computer hacking. The Mossad knew two days in advance of the bombing of the Marine Barracks at Beirut that killed 220. They waited to see if CIA would ever wake up.

Finally, one must ask, "Why would Israel push hard for oil exploration in the Tonkin Gulf"? If your enemy is Saudi Arabia, and they are planning to buy 60 F 16s, where does the money come from? Eliminate the source of the funds, eliminate the threat. When George Bush says the words, "New World Order", he's not talking about an international folk dancing festival. It would be disingenuous for any member of the committee to not recognize these aspects, especially if they always vote for increased aid to Israel.

Item 16

THE RUSSIAN CONNECTION. Two months ago, Boris Yeltsin comes to the United States and to the extreme consternation of George Bush, he cheerily announces that Russia grabbed large numbers of POWs from WWII, Korea and Vietnam and lots of them are still alive. My friends and relatives have newfound admiration for my intellect. Older veterans from WWII and Korea who were at best, apathetic to the POW/MIA Issue and considered Vietnam veterans "Sissies" are now showing up in large numbers at anti-government protest demonstrations.

As very well detailed in the book, "Bamboo Cage" by Nigel Cawthorne (Available from US Veteran, Kinston NC), the United States knew that American POWs were being flown from Sam Neua, Laos to Moscow. We tried on several occasions to intercept the planes but always fell short. It was determined later that the Walker Spy Ring tipped off the commies.

In April of 1984, three Vietnam POWs, all Marines, escaped from Russia. They were Schweckendorf, Sweeney and Greer. Like others, they were offered the choice of being killed, having thier memories erased with powerful drugs or accepting new identities under the witness protection program with the proviso they never contact their families. Greer escaped again; this time from the CIA. He is now a drug dealer living in Bangkok. His handler, Lee Atkins disappeared and presumably is somewhere peeling potatoes in a special CIA prison for screwups.

There are apparently quite a few new identities. These were discussed in the book "Kiss the Boys Goodbye" by Monika Stephenson. The person in charge of this operation is John Caveani. Two weeks ago, a caller to a live C-Span show described in detail the operation, how he passed the information to the committee and it disappeared into a black hole.

While we are on Russia, we need to deal with the comical attempt by DIA to debunk the Lundy,Robertson, Stephens photo. They showed their version of the picture supposedly from a magazine. However, the magazine was never published in Khmer or distributed to Cambodia. The DIA has the only copy in existence and the families are suing them to get to see it. DIA alleges that it is a retouched 1923 photo of men holding a picture of Stalin. That is impossible. Lenin was in power in 1923 and the picture of Stalin shows him as an old man. Please.

I personally talked to Special Ambassador Malcolm Toon at the National Alliance of Families meeting in Washington. He assured me that he travelled Russia extensively for five days and found no POWs, even though he looked everywhere. I was told he spent the time playing golf in the Urals. On 20/20, Tom Jarrell visited Tambov where he found lots of graves for American POWs and the keeper showed him the written records. He asked if Toon or any KGB Generals had been there and he was told, no, nobody in years. Jarrell also produced a picture for the first time seen anywhere of 4 American POWs and showed it to former NSA analyst Minarcin. Minarcin confirmed its authenticity. What I want to know is, how can a lone journalist, sent by a network barely making money scoop the entire US Intelligence Community including NRO and also the Senate Select Committee on POW/MIA ???

Item 17

ILLEGAL SURVEILLANCE OF AMERICAN CIVILIANS BY ARMY INTELLIGENCE

In 1968 and 1969, the US Army's 113th Military Intelligence unit with offices at Evanston, IL, Baltimore and Washington DC engaged in a domestic spying (DOMEX) mission against anti-war groups in flagrant violation of U.S. Law. They even formed their own group, Legion of Justice. They siezed all data from Jane Fonda. This included tapes of US POWs being interrogated by Russians. Fonda herself was thought to be a CIA Mole sent to Vietnam to retrieve certain particular pilots. She did manage to bring out more POWs than the last four Presidents combined. David Duke's father was involved and later joined Bush in China. This is one of the most bizarre intrigues in Intelligence history and also included Gordon Liddy. This story is detailed in Readers Digest earlier this year. The codeword for this operation is Garden Plat. The committee is presumably too interested in harassing activists to look into it.

Item 18

MEDUSA AND HADES, DRAGON LADIES OF THE POW/MIA ISSUE. It's not nice to mess with Mother Nature. When the government wants to really get mean with someone, they always send a woman. In this case, the plague of the POW/MIA Movement is two women, Frances Zwenig and Ann Mills-Griffith, the most hated women in America today. They have done more to keep live Americans in captivity in Vietnam than any other group of people, American or communist. They both in salary and benefits make more than a U.S. Senator.

Zwenig just went to Hanoi by herself where she was told exactly what it was she would do when she returned to the U.S. The communist Vietnamese are "Fed up" with a bunch of family members and activists interfering with their oil deal with Mobil. Better run boys, here comes Frances. She also patrols the aisles looking for people to kick out of the hearings and send to detention.

Sweet Ann has quite a history. She is a Mata Hari who has more security clearances than anyone at CIA and more lovers than Madonna. In the Peck and Wiand Reports, she has been romantically linked to General Lawson, Admirals Paulsen and Tuttle, Congressmen Solarz and Lagomarsino and Richard Childress. They say she has an intelligence network on Capitol Hill that has never been equalled and is the envy of everyone. Once loyal to the POW movement, she was co-opted to work for the government's interests in quashing the issue and now has her own agenda that no one is exactly sure of. She spends most of her time writing letters requesting donations. The committee is very quiet and sheepish when it gets around her. Why is that?

Item 19

U.S. GOVERNMENT DENIES EXISTENCE OF POWs BUT ORGANIZES RESCUE MISSIONS. For the last 20 years, the government has denied that there is even one live POW in all of Southeast Asia. Yet over the years there have been numerous rescue attempts. These missions had codenames Duck Soup, Grand Eagle and Velvet Hammer, none of which were successful. There are rumors that there were some that did succeed. In the book, "After the Hero's Welcome" by Dorothy McDaniel, an account is made of a conversation with a former POW and two Delta Force operatives. They said that they were in lockdown for two separate POW rescue missions in Laos in the late 80s which were cancelled at the last moment. Would it be too much trouble to ask the committee to look into this?

Item 20

DELTA AIRLINES LOVES COMMUNISTS. American businesses are so obsessed with lust for money they forget who they are dealing with. In their eagerness for the trade embargo to be dropped, Delta invited the Air Minister from Hanoi to Atlanta for a spare-no-expense tour of the facility and junket to Disneyworld. He was even allowed to fly the Jumbo simulator. This person's claim to fame was that he has eight confirmed kills of U.S. Aircraft during the war but that didn't seem to bother Delta. It is tenuous to presume they might have discussed the immediate return of live American POWs while they sipped Dom Perignon and nibbled Steak Diane. Why doesn't the committee look into treasonous behavior such as this?

Item 21

CLOSED TESTIMONY DESIGNED TO PROTECT EGOS-NOT NATIONAL SECURITY. A perfect example of this are the open and closed sessions with Barry Allen Toll. The open said he saw messages from Kissinger to Nixon during the Paris Peace talks about the 400 POWs left in Laos. The closed testimony (which I have seen) talks about the immense damage done by the Walker Spy ring and how they were recruited and managed by KGB General Kalugin. Toll ratfinked on Walker five times and nothing was ever done. Reputations were on the line, however, so the committee did what it was told and covered the whole matter up. Why didn't Congress save the taxpayers money by hiring twelve ditch diggers with shovels instead of 12 high-priced senators to deal with the issue? People in Washington selling shredders and blankets should be able to retire before this committee is finished.

Item 22

SECRET SOCIETIES IMPEDE THE RESOLUTION OF THE POW/MIA ISSUE.

Just like the names of the Old CIA hands in Laos in 1963 keep turning up in scandal after scandal over the years, are there other groups equally as malevolent? How about Skull and Bones at Yale? George Bush and John Kerry are members. So is Arlen Specter (Ran the Show at the Clarence THomas hearings) and David Boren, Chairman of the Senate Intelligence Committee. What do these names all have in common; Nance, Perot, Ptak, North, Poindexter, Studeman, Watkins, Busey, McFarlane, Armitage and McCain? (Thye all went to Annapolis and may be members of the outlawed "Green Bowlers"). How many members of the Senate belong to the Friar's Club? Hasty Pudding? Phi Delta Theta? Masons? Item 23

Item24

MEDIA BIAS AGAINST THE POW/MIA ISSUE. The government seems to be able to slant public opinion any way it wants to by effective manipulation of the media. There have been brutal exposees of photo debunking. Two television programs did a hatchet job on Jack Bailey. Jim Bamford at ABC took off on a noted activist. Larry King at CNN got into a cozy little chat with drug dealer Oliver North at the Republican National Convention. In this live interview, North was cued to say that all the people outside the Astrodome protesting POW/MIA were all "Draft crad burners". We asked Larry King for a chance to refute Norths charges. Safe to say we never got the opportunity. The "Spotlight" newspaper has a word for these people; they call them "Journalistic Prostitutes". This aspect of the issue has been conspicuously ignored by the committee.

Item 25

A JOB NOBODY NOW WANTS-HEAD OF POW AFFAIRS FOR DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY. Colonel Peck started the whole ball rolling with his letter of resignation in disgust which caused the Helms Report to be written on the mindset to debunk mentality of the agency. Major Schlatter chimed in saying Peck was full of it but he tried a little too hard. The last person, USMC Major Charles W Gittens settled himself into the job and immediately developed "Ollie North Syndrome" and made a lot of enemies. Nobody is sure what he did to whom; but the man has departed for parts unknown with an uncertain future. Item 26

If military matters were important to Bush, he would have resolved POW, never hired Derwinski to mess up VA Hospitals, and would be doing more for GIs with weird diseases from Desert Storm and homeless veterans. Eisenhower abandoned 45,000 POWs in WWII and 9,000 in Korea and never had a pay raise in 8 years for the military. Carter the veteran let military morale and prowess slip to its lowest level. Clinton certainly couldn't do any worse and I trust him a lot more than I do Bush. Admiral Crowe, former chairman JCS, endorsed Clinton. VFW National and Gen. Schwarzkopf refused to endorse anybody. Item 27

Whether that hurts jobs or the economy is not important to them, only profits, big profits. Hunt Oil of Dallas has been secretly and successfully drilling for Oil in Laos for the last three years. The chairman of the Texas Bush/Quayle 1992 committee is Jim Oberwetter. He is on loan from Hunt Oil. Care to investigate that, committee people?

Item 28

WHERE DO VIETNAMESE-AMERICANS STAND ON ALL THIS? There are now almost one million ethnic Vietnamese living in the United States. These are boat people and their next generation. 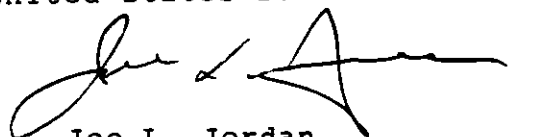
