Your Help Is Needed To Get The Word Out To Your Organization,
Your Community/Local Media and Other POW/MIA Organizations...

As some of you are no doubt aware, there is reason to believe that the United States Government made arrangements in the mid 1980's for the Secret Return of a number of POW's from Southeast Asia. For what purpose were they brought out and why haven't they surfaced... or have they, in one form or another?

One such case, is believed to be that of Robert "Curtis" Borton Jr., U.S.M.C., from Benton Harbor, MI who was listed as Missing In Action on August 28, 1966. Curt's sister, Diane "Borton" Ziegler who is an Associate of the Pacific Northwest Chapter of VietNow, has reason to believe he made it out of Southeast Asia and returned to the United States. Last winter, Diane provided the producers of the TV show, "Unsolved Mysteries", with overwhelming evidence about why she is certain Curt had returned. We were all under the impression that the show was going to air on several previous occasions, but for whatever reason it did not.

Recently word came down that "Unsolved Mysteries" was going to air this hour long segment, entitled "Borton Is Back", on December 9, 1994 on the NBC TV Network. Two days ago I talked to Catherine Cromley, co-producer of "Unsolved Mysteries", in an attempt to confirm that "Borton Is Back" will be shown on December 9, 1994. Ms. Cromley told me that the program is "tentatively" scheduled to be aired on December 9th on NBC, however she could not confirm that until December 2nd.

The problem is, if we wait until December 2nd to confirm that the program is in fact going to air on December 9th, it only gives us a week to get the word out to you and not enough time for you to spread the word to anyone else. So, I would suggest that you tell everyone that the program will most likely air the evening of December 9th and to Check Your Local TV Listing! You might want to record this on your VCR!
