SUGGESTIONS FOR LOBBYING CAPITOL HILL - THURSDAY JULY 20, 1995

EACH FAMILY MEMBER IS IMPOLED TO CONTACT THEIR SENATORS TO DEMAND THAT THE ORIGINAL LANGUAGE OF S 256 THE MISSING SERVICE PERSONNEL ACT, OF 1995, BE SUBSTITUTED FOR THE SUB COMMITTEE LANGUAGE, SUBTITLE E- OTHER MATTERS SEC. 551, DETERMINATION OF WHEREABOUTS, AND STATUS OF MISSING PERSONS, TO BE ATTACHED TO THE SENATE DOD APPROPORATIONS BILL FOR FY 1996.

THIS SUB-COMMITTEE LANGUAGE DOES NOT PROVIDE THE RETROACTIVE DUE PROCESS THAT S 256 PROVIDES TO THE FAMILIES. IT ALSO DROPS THE PHRASE PRISONER OF WAR FROM THE CATEGORY OF "MISSING."

THESE AND OTHER SHORTCOMINGS MUST BE CORRECTED.
