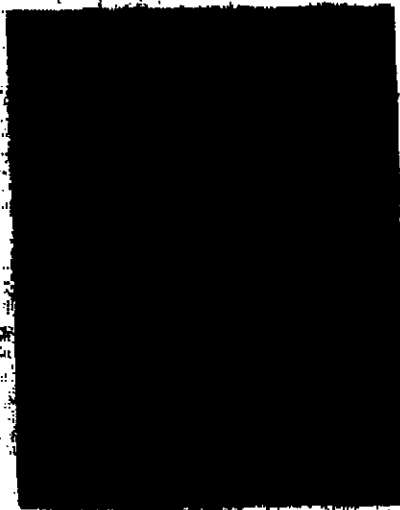


Commitment to Service

Chair officers have been dispatched on several missions to investigate progress being made in Indochina. And we are pushing for North Korea to cooperate.

Yet only by exerting maximum pressure on the Communist regimes will the fate of the men lost in Southeast Asia ever be resolved. Lifting the trade embargo against Hanoi was not the move to make at this time. Any further concessions should be vehemently opposed until it is verified that the Vietnamese are fully cooperating with U.S. teams.
