The following information was related by Source to interviewer as fact. In August (approximately) 1984, Source met her brother Ho Xung Minh of 84/3 Phan Dinh Phung St., Hue City at her house at 134/1 Nguyen Thanh Hien St., District 4, HCMC, when he told her that he had in his possession the remains, dog tag and ID card of an American killed in Vietnam which had been discovered in the Hue area (date, circumstances and location unknown). The remains were of a US captain who was a pilot. Source was uncertain as to the original finder, but remembered the main point of her discussion with Minh was the fact that he personally possessed the remains. Present location of the remains is unknown to Source.

Minh requested Source to report this information to the US authorities after her departure and requested she carry along the ID card of the deceased, but she refused. Source personally saw neither the remains, dog tag nor ID card. Source's brother, Minh, is hoping the US will contact him directly.
