The following information was related by Source to interviewer as fact. Sometime in January 1984, Source met his cousin, Le Thi Tim of 98//111/13 Cach Mang Thang Tam St, Tan Binh District, HCMC who told him that she had a relative (NFI) who lives in Song Be (P) who had discovered the grave site of an American somewhere deep in the jungle (NFI). A dog tag was also discovered at the site (whether exhumed or not, unknown). The remains were left at the site and the dog tag was brought back to the 98/111/13 address where it is currently hidden.

Source did not personally see any dog tag but was shown by Tim a photocopy of a dog tag. Source could not recall any information from the dog tag. Tim requested Source to take the photocopy out of Vietnam upon his departure to report to the US authorities, but Source refused, for security reasons.

Source recommends that if the US wants more information from Tim, a safe way to obtain it would be to call Tim into the ODP office at Thu Duc for a resettlement interview, which would provide a safe environment to question and obtain the information concerning the grave site.
