Information: Source reported hearsay information obtained from his friend, Mr. Nguyen Xuan Lang (DOB 1932, residing in Phu Nhuan District, HCM City). Lang has a nephew (NFI) who, while held in re-education camp K-18 near Hoai-An Village (BR8087), allegedly discovered the remains, dogtags, and other personal effects of two Americans. This incident was eventually discovered by SRV officials, however, and the nephew was arrested and the remains were confiscated (perhaps around December 1983). Source is willing to provide additional details if contacted in the U.S.

Source also reported hearsay info obtained from an old friend and former PAVN Lt Colonel, Nguyen Van Kinh (currently living in Hanoi) and a Mr. Thien (FNU) who works at the Hanoi TV station. According to these two individuals, Vietnamese authorities are still retaining 70-80 American POWs in Hanoi.
