Eleven 16mm, black and white motion picture films with sound tracks, produced by the NVA and VC Liberation Film Studios between 1965 and 68, are newsreels and long feature films depicting NVA air defense activities in NVN, miscellaneous VC propaganda activities, and the capture of downed US pilots. Following is a brief summary of the captured VC/NVA films:

(U) Item #1: Reel 1: The film, entitled "Congress Of The People's Representatives For the Formation of the VC Provisional Revolutionary Government of the RVN", was produced in 1969 by the VC Liberation Film Studio. It begins by showing scenes in which Nguyen Huu Tho and Nguyen Thi Binh are seen giving addresses. Subsequent scenes show the participants electing the VC Provisional Revolutionary Government Cabinet members by a show of hands ((the film consists of two reels; however, only one of them was captured)).

(U) Item #2: Reel No 2: Newsreel, produced by the Liberation Motion Picture Section in 1966, shows Madame Nguyen Thi Binh's visit to a meeting of the Vietnamese Women's Association.

(U) Item #3: Reel No 3: Mickey Mouse cartoon.

(U) Item #4: Reel No 4: Film, entitled "The Cam River Battlefield", was made by the NVN Film Studio in 1966. It begins by representing activities of NVA Naval units protecting North Vietnamese industrial plants located along the Cam River. A scene of a US prisoner of war (name unknown) on a boat, who was captured by NVA Naval units, is shown.

(U) Item #5: Reel No 5: The film, entitled "Hon Me Island", was made in NVN by the NVA Motion Picture Studio in 1968. It depicts the NVA Coastal Defense units on Hon Me Island in action against US warships. The film ends with a statement that NVA units on the island had downed over 20 US aircraft and sunk 6 warships.

(U) Item #6: Reels No 6 & 7: The film, entitled "The Ham Rong Bridge Defenders", was produced in 1967 by the NVA Film Studio. It depicts activities of NVA antiaircraft units protecting the Ham Rong Bridge in Thanh Hoa Prov, NVN. A scene of one US pilot ((name unknown)) captured by the NVA is shown.

CAPTURE DATA

(U) Item #7: Reels No 8-9-10: A long feature and propaganda film, entitled "O Tam Forest", produced in NVN, describes the story of Miss Tam and her family's poor life, in a forest in NVN. The film, begins by showing the building of a cottage by her father. It ends with a scene in which Tam's family and her friends are seen constructing wooden bridges so that NVA trucks can move over bomb craters.

(U) Item #8: Reel No 11: The film, entitled "Shooting Down the 2,500th US Aircraft", was made by the NVA Film Studio. It covers activities of NVA antiaircraft units in NVN. A photo and the US ID Card of a US pilot named ROBERT WATERMAN are shown.

(U) Item #9: Reel No 12: Newsreel No 4-1967 is composed of two parts. Part I was made by the VC Liberation Film Studio and Part II by the NVA Film Studio. The first part covers activities of the Assault Youth Group of Binh Duong Province, and a scene of several RVNAP prisoners of war who were captured during a VC attack on Vo Xu ((date unknown)). These PWs are seen attending a political indoctrination session conducted by the VC capturing unit. The second part shows the wreckage of a US aircraft downed by the NVA in the Ham Hong Bridge area, with the following details written on a small metal plate: Aircraft No 992, Part No 21-151020-20, control No 85-300A and serial No NO2-638. A photo and the US ID Card of a US pilot with the rank of Major are shown ((the name is not legible, possible HAMER or COLLIER)). The film ends with a scene showing the capture of approximately 15 US pilots. Some of them died or were wounded when their aircraft were downed. A prisoner of war named ALVAREZ (Reel #13 below) is shown.

(U) Item #10: Reel No 13: The film, entitled "Determined to Emerge Victorious Over the US Aggressors", was produced in 1965. The film is composed of various scenes similar to those shown in Reels No 57 and 80, which were published in the CDEC Film Synopsis, dated 31-Dec 71. The film begins by showing the wreckage of US F101 and F105D aircraft. Military ID Cards of US prisoners of war, such as ID Card No 646194 belonging to LT EDWARD A. DICKSON, ID Card No 9530447 belonging to CPT CARILLYLE D. HARRIS, which was issued on 21 Jan 65; and ALVAREZ in person are shown.

(U) Item #11: Reels No 14 & 15: The film, entitled "The History of the Party", was produced in 1966. It describes past activities of the Indochinese Communist Party during the period 1930 to 1960.
