Dear Mr. Ross,

It has been less than two weeks since I received a copy of the enclosed transcript from the "Larry King Live" show from my mother. She sent it immediately after receiving it herself. You can't imagine the shock of receiving information about my father "third-hand" via a television program, without first being notified of the new information from my Casualty Officer, Mr. George Atkinson. My family has since contacted Mr. Atkinson ourselves without receiving any understanding or logical explanation of the situation and/or change of his status from KIA-BNR - to possibly POW.

After reading the transcript, my mother, Barbara Lundeen, has also made contact with Bob Smith's office and has spoken to several representatives to persons involved in POW-MIA affairs. Most significantly, she spoke with Mr. Dussault, whom has claimed to be the person responsible for evaluating the satellite photo and interpreting the code "72 TA 88 SEREX" which is mentioned in the transcript. Mr. Dussault stated to her that

although he was unable to verify or deny the presence of my father in Viet Nam today, he believes the code to be very significant to my father's case. He admitted to giving Bob Smith & Billy Hendon the evidence of the satellite photo in a closed, classified meeting of the Dept. of Defense to brief them on evidence of new information and names.

I am formally requesting immediate delivery of any new information which pertains or could possibly pertain to my father's case. I specifically request a copy of the satellite photo mentioned in the enclosed transcript, along with all interpretations thereof. The following are current addresses and telephone numbers of my family members. May I mention that my mother's address and phone number has not changed in the 21 years of my father's status.
