SUBJECT: Information Received on Lt Col Anthony C. Shine, USAF

1. This office recently received information from an ex- "Lao resistance" member who just returned from a trip to Southeast Asia. While there, he visited Laos for one evening where he met a former colleague. The colleague claims to possess the remains and dog tags of five U.S. servicemen. He provided his friend with the name of one of these servicemen, Lt Col Anthony C. Shine, USAF. The colleague purportedly is part of a group of Lao who buy and sell remains. The U.S. Government policy prohibiting payment for information or remains, was explained to the source. He promised to forward a letter from his colleague that allegedly contains more information. As you are aware, Lt Col Shine has been the subject of previous dog tag reports.

2. Upon receipt of the colleague's letter, or further details, it will be forwarded to your office for transmittal to the next of kin.
