SUBJECT: Information Received on Capt Anthony Shine, USAF

1. An American citizen received information from a Lao refugee who had returned from a trip to Laos. The refugee allegedly had information pertaining to three Americans who are missing in Southeast Asia. Of the three names and accompanying data provided by the refugee, only one actually correlated to an unaccounted for American, Capt Shine. The refugee inquired about compensation for the remains. He was told that the U.S. Government has a policy of not paying compensation for the turnover of remains. As you are aware, this is not the first time Capt Shine's name has surfaced in dog tag reports.
