Dear Sir:

I received, on 8 April 1993, reviewed and evaluated the enclosures supporting the identification of CILHI 0008-93 as the remains of Captain Harley H. Hall, , USN.

Comments: It is understood that this identification rests on the dental match of three teeth and postmortem dental x-rays of CILHI 0008-93 are compared with the antemortem dental x-rays and records of CAPT Hall. The anthropological summary is of little value in this case due to the condition of very sparse remains. The summary of incident, with respect to time and place, and witness interviews are all commensurate with REFNO 1982.

Recommendation: Based on my review of the material presented including the dental analysis, supported by the summary of incident, I recommend that the remains designated as CILHI 0008-93 be identified as the remains of Captain Harley H. Hall, , USN.
