NARRATIVE

ON 22 OCTOBER 1967, LIEUTENANT JUNIOR GRADE JAMES E. DOOLEY WAS FLYING AN A-4E ATTACK BOMBER ON A STRIKE MISSION. HIS AIRCRAFT, SERIAL NUMBER 150116, WAS HIT BY ANTI-AIRCRAFT ARTILLERY FIRE AND CRASHED IN THE VICINITY OF GRID COORDINATES XH890990, AT THE MOUTH OF THE HAIPHONG RIVER, SOUTHEAST OF HAI PHONG CITY, HAI PHONG PROVINCE. ANOTHER AIRCREW IN THE STRIKE FORCE SAW HIS AIRCRAFT IMPACT THE WATER. A SEARCH OF THE CRASH SITE AREA WAS CONDUCTED WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS.
