Dear Mr. Wingate,

I appreciate your interest in the POW-MIA issue. The Joint Casualty Resolution Center (JCRC) and the Joint Task Force-Full Accounting (JTF-FA) passed information folders and requested information regarding Lieutenant Mossman during technical meetings with Vietnamese government representatives in December 1982, September 1985, and again in March 1992. We have received no additional information from the Vietnamese on this case. JTF-FA analysts continue to review information gathered during Joint Field Investigations for clues which may assist in the resolution of this case.

The JTF-FA holds technical meetings with Cambodian officials on a regular basis to coordinate future Joint Field Activities in Cambodia. Information regarding unaccounted for personnel is routinely exchanged during these discussions.

The JTF-FA is an operational unit and is only authorized to release information on its mission activities through command public affairs officers and to the service casualty branches for the next of kin (NOK). In the future, I recommend that you submit a request under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) to the Bureau of Naval Personnel, Attn: PERS 663P, Washington, D.C. 20370-5663, (703) 614-3338, for information concerning U.S. Navy unaccounted for personnel.
