Dear Senator Wofford:

Thank you for your letter of January 14, 1994, on behalf of Mr. Bobby Wingate and Mrs. Dianne M. Mossman, regarding their request for information concerning Lieutenant Junior Grade Joe R. Mossman, United States Naval Reserve, Deceased.

Mr. Wingate is concerned that the information passed to the Vietnamese government at technical meetings in 1982, 1985, and 1992 has not been provided to Mrs. Mossman. We forwarded this information to Mrs. Mossman on March 18, 1993. This same information, which is contained in Lieutenant Mossman's casualty file, was provided to Mrs. Mossman in 1984 and 1991.

Mr. Wingate's concerns regarding the correlation made in the third paragraph of the Case Narrative were previously expressed to our POW/MIA Liaison Office. On November 30, 1993, that office forwarded to Mrs. Mossman a Joint Task Force-Full Accounting letter stating that the "aircraft type" comment should have been omitted from the correlation statement. A corrected copy of the Case Narrative was provided to the Vietnamese Government.

I hope this is helpful.
