

... by interview, Lt Col Mather: Mr. Gays knowledge of the main camp was over the wall from where he was imprisoned in space. He only passed through this area on his way to his own cell down by the reservoir. Upon his recapture after his escape attempt, he was held in the middle of the three buildings marked "Maximum Security". This maximum security area was bounded by a concrete or masonry wall 40 meters by 100 meters by 3 meters high. The two "towers" indicated by Mr. Gays are not four-legged watch towers, but are made of masonry with tile roofs. The entrance to the camp from the main road is via the most northerly road which he has drawn. Except for these notes, all the remaining marks on this sketch are those of Mr. Gays.
