27 GULDEN, Frederick - Architect based in Bangkok (has exit visa)

Nie (son - Former CARE employee; Apt. 569/23 Gia Long  
(do not appear to have exit visas)

31 HUGHES, Richard - Former Shoeshine Boys Director (does not have  
exit visa)

32 HORTON, Paul - Former International Voluntary Service Worker,  
now working at Bien Hoa Mental Hospital

33,34,35 KAJI, Andrew Tsurugi, wife and possibly one child - living at  
Vung Tau (possibly farming)

- 57, 58, 59 POLLARD, Perry V., wife and child - living in Quan Tin across the river
- 60, 61 POSNER, Gerald; Lan (Mrs.) - Ex-military (both have exit visas)
- 62 REED, Teresa - Religious worker (has exit visa)
- 63, 64 REGAN, Lon Thi (Mrs.); John David (son) - U.S. Permanent Resident (Husband in U.S.) last known address was 85/C Cao Thang, Saigon 3. Both have exit visas.
- 65, 66, 67 RIOS, Jose; wife and child - Former military, no exit visas
- 68 RIVERA, Frederick A. - Aircraft maintenance specialist
- 69 SMITH, William - Ex-military (has exit visa)
- 70 THOMAS, Fernando K.
- 71 THOMASEN, Ford - Former contract worker with Federal Electronics Corporation (has exit visa)
- 72, 73 TRAN Thi Lieu (also known as TRAN Thi Lieu Rizzotto), wife of John Rizzotto. She is U.S. permanent resident with son Tran Thi Phoung, who is American citizen
