



PREVIOUS INTERVIEWEES WHO APPEARED TO HAVE GOOD RECALL BUT WERE RELUCTANT TO SHARE THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF THE WARTIME CAMP SYSTEM AND CADRE. SOURCE'S LIMITED INFORMATION, WHEN VIEWED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THAT PROVIDED BY PREVIOUS SOURCES, MAY BEGIN TO FORM A BASIS FOR A BETTER ANALYSIS OF THE WARTIME EPO/EPD APPARATUS.

B. SOURCE'S VAGUE RECOLLECTION OF INTER-CAMPS "A" AND "B" AS WELL AS CAMPS B-22 AND B-23 MAY INDICATE THAT THESE ARE COVER DESIGNATIONS FOR THE SAME CAMPS AT VARYING LOCATIONS. SOURCE SEEMED SURPRISED AT THE MENTION OF A CAMP WITH A "C" DESIGNATION AND GAVE THE IMPRESSION HE WAS DOUBTFUL CONCERNING THE EXISTENCE OF ANY SUCH CAMP.

016907Z APR 93). THE CAMP COMMANDER OF INTER-CAMP "A" WAS TAM (B) HUY. (NOTE: SR COL HUY WAS INTERVIEWED IN BEN THE ON 24 OCT 89, SEE JCRC BKK MSG 270246Z NOV 89). THE CADRE IN CHARGE OF THE PROVISIONAL REVOLUTIONARY GOVERNMENT DELEGATION ESCORTING US POW'S TO THEIR RELEASE POINT AT LOC NINH IN 1973 WAS SR COL PHAM VAN LUC, AKA NAM (5) LUG. (NOTE: PREVIOUS SOURCES HAVE INDICATED THAT SR COL LUC WAS KIA BY B-52 STRIKE PRIOR TO THE 1973 RELEASE. THESE SAME SOURCES HAVE ALSO INDICATED THAT SR COL LUC DID PARTICIPATE IN THE EXCHANGES OF US FOR COMMUNIST POW'S THAT OCCURRED PRIOR TO 1973). A WARTIME CHIEF OF THE EPO IN THE SOUTH WAS SR COL TUYEN (TUYENS). SR COL TUYEN REPLACED SR COL NGO DUC TAR SOMETIME DURING THE EARLY 1970'S. WHEN THE WAR ENDED IN 1975, SR COL TUYEN BECAME THE VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE PROVINCE PEOPLE'S COMMITTEE IN SONG BE PROVINCE. SOURCE BELIEVES SR COL TUYEN IS NOW RETIRED AND RESIDING IN THU DUC.

5. OTHER CADRE RECALLED BY SOURCE INCLUDE: INTERPRETER NGUYEN HUNG TRI, NOW RESIDING IN HANOI. (NOTE: PREVIOUSLY INTERVIEWED); SAU (6) KEO (KEOS), A CADRE OF INTER-CAMP "A", NOW DECEASED; BA (3) CAN (CANH), A CADRE OF INTER-CAMP "A", POSSIBLY CURRENTLY RESIDING IN CU CHI DISTRICT OF HCMC; DANG TRUAN HOA, ALSO A CADRE OF INTER-CAMP "A", NOW RESIDING IN HCMC. (NOTE: ALREADY INTERVIEWED); TU MAO, A CADRE OF THE EPO ASSIGNED TO THE SAIGON AREA DURING THE WAR. (NOTE: TRUONG HUYNH MAO, AKA HUYNH KIM TRUONG, AKA TU MAO, AKA TU TRUONG WAS INTERVIEWED ON 12 MAR 93 AND THE RESULTS WILL BE FORWARDED SEPARATELY). RAO BINH, THE FORMER GUARD FORCE COMMANDER OF INTER-CAMP "A". (NOTE: INTERVIEWED PREVIOUSLY); DAN MANH, AKA BA (3) MANH, THE FORMER POLITICAL OFFICER OF CAMP B-22, NOW RESIDING IN BA RIA-VUNG TAU. (NOTE: ACCORDING TO LTC PHAM TEO, DAN MANH WAS INTERVIEWED BY AN INVESTIGATION ELEMENT DURING A PREVIOUS JFA). INTERPRETER LE HOA (HOAF), DECEASED; INTERPRETER UT RUE (HUEJ), DECEASED; TRF INTELLIGENCE OFFICER OF THE EPO (PHONG 2), NGUYEN TAN LUC, WHO DIED IN VUNG TAU AFTER THE WAR ENDED;

6. WHEN ASKED CONCERNING HIS KNOWLEDGE OF A CADRE CALLED TRAN CHAU, SOURCE SAID HE COULD ONLY RECALL TWO CADRE CALLED "CHAU", BUT WAS NOT ABLE TO RECALL THEIR SURNAMES. HE RECALLED THAT ONE MEDIC ASSIGNED TO INTER-CAMP "A" WAS CALLED "CHAU" AND HE DIED DURING THE WAR. ANOTHER CADRE CALLED "CHAU" WAS A SR LT IN THE POLICY SECTION WHO RETURNED TO HANOI AFTER THE WAR AND WAS ASSIGNED TO A PRISON CAMP AT THANH LIET. (NOTE: AKA HANOI B AND THE SAME PRISON VISITED BY THE SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE DURING APRIL 1992). CONCERNING FORMER CADRE OF THE MILITARY REGIONS WHO MIGHT BE ABLE TO PROVIDE INFORMATION OF POW/MIA INTEREST, SOURCE SAID THE ONLY NAME HE CAN RECALL IS TAM (B) HIEN (HIENF). THE FORMER COMMANDER OF MR-9, SOURCE VAGUELY RECALLED TAM HIEN'S TRUE NAME AS NGUYEN MINH NHU (NHUW).

7. COMMENTS:

A. SOURCE WAS COOPERATIVE BUT APPEARED TO HAVE POOR RECALL REGARDING SPECIFICS. THIS WAS IN CONTRAST TO
