WE SHOULD MIMIC OUR RECENT DOCUMENTS RESEARCH SUCCESSES AND ENCOURAGE AND TRUST OUR VIETNAMESE COUNTERPARTS TO HELP US IDENTIFY WITNESSES WHO CAN HELP. FOR EXAMPLE, SRCOL PHAM DUC DAI, DIR OF THE ARMED FORCES MUSEUM IN HANOI, SAID HE COULD IDENTIFY PAVN VETERANS WHO COULD HAVE INFORMATION ABOUT U.S. LOSSES IN LAOS. ALSO, DURING GENERAL JOHN VESSEY'S 18-19 APRIL 1993 VISIT TO HANOI, HE AND SRV FOREIGN MINISTER NGUYEN MANH CAM AGREED TO EXPLORE WHETHER THE U.S. MIGHT ISSUE APPEALS FOR INFORMATION IN THE NEWSLETTER PUBLISHED BY THE VIETNAMESE VETERANS ORGANIZATION.

(27) INTERVIEW OF ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING PERSONS WHO HELPED WRITE PAVN'S OFFICIAL HISTORY OF THE HCM TRAIL, PUBLISHED BY THE GENERAL DIRECTORATE FOR REAR SERVICES IN 1988. WE INVITE THE VNOSMP TO RECOMMEND WHICH OF THE EDITORS, CO-AUTHORS, AND RESEARCHERS WE SHOULD INTERVIEW. IT SHOULD NOT BE NECESSARY TO TALK TO EACH OF THESE PERSONS. WE INVITE SUGGESTIONS FROM THE VNOSMP CONCERNING THE MOST EFFECTIVE WAY TO CONDUCT THE INTERVIEW, FOR EXAMPLE A GROUP INTERVIEW, OR SEMINAR, MIGHT HELP THE WITNESSES COMBINE THEIR KNOWLEDGE AND CONSERVE TIME AND RESOURCES.

ON 13 APR 93, SRCOL PHAM DUC DAI, DIR OF THE ARMED FORCES MUSEUM, HANOI, RECOMMENDED DET 2 RESEARCHER/HISTORIAN SHOULD INTERVIEW SRCOL SON FOR INFORMATION ABOUT DOCUMENTS AND POTENTIAL WITNESSES CONCERNING U.S. LOSSES IN LAOS. SRCOL DAI SAID HE COULD ARRANGE CONTACT.

(29) GROUP INTERVIEW OF FORMER CADRE OF THE MR-9 POW CAMP IN CONJUNCTION WITH AN EXCURSION INTO THE U-MINH FOREST TO LOCATE GRAVES OF THE U.S. POWS WHO DIED IN THE CAMP--A SIGNIFICANT GOAL. MR. BELL INTERVIEWED NGUYEN CHI CONG (AKA 7 CONG), FORMER COMMANDER OF THE MR 9 POW CAMP, ON 5 MARCH 1993. HIS SON, HAI THANH, WHO WAS A GUARD AT THE CAMP, AND THE DEPUTY CAMP COMMANDER, A MAN NAMED MUOI THANH, REPORTEDLY ALSO ARE AVAILABLE. SRCOL TRAN BIEN, DY DIR OF VNOSMP, SAID HE AND HIS STAFF HAVE SPOKEN WITH THESE PERSONS AND MIGHT BE ABLE TO IDENTIFY OTHER FORMER CADRE OF THIS CAMP. TYPICALLY, FORMER CADRE HAVE BEEN EAGER TO BE HELPFUL, BUT TEND TO HAVE LOST SPECIFIC DETAILS FROM INDIVIDUAL MEMORY. ALSO, THE TERRAIN IN MANY AREAS HAS CHANGED SIGNIFICANTLY IN THE LAST 20 YEARS. IF THESE PERSONS COULD BE BROUGHT TOGETHER FOR INTERVIEW AND A JOINT SEARCH EXCURSION, THEY MIGHT BE ABLE TO REINFORCE EACH OTHER'S MEMORY AND LEAD US TO THE GRAVE SITES IN QUESTION. NGUYEN CHI CONG IS ABOUT 70 YEARS OLD, AND SUFFERING FROM HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE; THEREFORE, HE MAY NOT BE ABLE TO ACCOMPANY A FIELD TEAM. NEVERTHELESS, WE SHOULD ACCOMPLISH THIS INITIATIVE WHILE HE REMAINS HEALTHY.
