REQUEST FOR INFORMATION  
V211 HOSPITAL AND PW CAMPS 101/102

Dr. Diep, a former coroner at V211 hospital described V211 as being located on a hilltop named HO mountain. This hospital served 2 nearby PW camps named TA GIAC and TA BOP because of 2 rivers located near these camps. I believe the PREK NAM DIAR and the TA POK rivers could possibly be the 2 rivers Dr. Diep was referring to because of the similarity when pronounced in Vietnamese. The hill mass located between these 2 rivers on the CB border vic 48P YA525605 could be the HO mountain. This mountain is not very high, (only 710 meters), but in relationship to the terrain to the east and west of it, it could be considered a significant hill. Per conversation with Mr. Bell/Det 1 on 23 Mar 93, B3 Headquarters was located in close proximity to this hill mass at 48P YA5958. Mr. Bell also stated that the helicopter loss associated with the raid on V211, (source - debrief of Dr. Diep and Dr. Le Cao Dai), was probably a mission on or about 16 May 70, not in 1969 like Dr. Diep remembered or in 1971 per Dr. Le Cao Dai's statement. Mr. Bell believes V211 was located vic 48P YA6440 however, no OPLOSS could be found in that area during that time frame. There was an UH-1 OPLOSS on 6 May 1970 vic 48P YA483617 which is approximately 3-4km from the hill mass at 48P YA525605. Per PW reports, camps 101/102 were located almost due west of Pleiku and a large flat area could be seen in the east. From this hill mass, U.S. operations could easily be detected to the east or the west.

1. Request information on the following:

A. Information on UH-1 OPLOSS on 06 May 70, USA, Veh# 6815412, lost vic 48P YA483617. Please include if possible, details of mission or target, debriefs of personnel on board, and circumstances of loss.

B. Request that you contact Mr. Bell/Det 1 to see if this correlates to the OPLOSS he was referring to in our meeting on 23 Mar 93. If it does, please check for any additional information he may be able to provide about this OPLOSS, V211 or PW camps 101/102.

C. Analyst assessment for V211 is hill top vic 48P YA5159 and YA5260. I put camp 102 at YA4962 and camp 101 at YA4859. Request analysis of this assessment.
