SUBJECT: Compilation of Key POW/MIA Lists for Vietnam

During discussions today with Senator John Kerry regarding his pending trips to Vietnam, he made the request that we provide him a comprehensive list of key Vietnamese POW/MIA related documents we have requested and not received over the past 2 years. He also requested a list of individuals whom we have been seeking to interview such as LTC Doan Manh who General Vessey was allowed to interview just recently. The Senator intends to present these lists to the Vietnamese in Hanoi next week. Although we have given such lists to the Vietnamese in the past, there appears to be utility in repeating the gesture in light of recent developments.

Request JTFFA and DIA jointly compile a comprehensive list of key Vietnamese individuals we believe we must have access to in order to have the greatest impact on our efforts to achieve our objective of the FPA. This list should include individuals identified through previous interviews, referrals, the oral history program and other appropriate sources.

Request DIA compile a comprehensive list of the major Vietnamese POW/MIA related documents we believe we must have access to in order to achieve our objective of the FPA.

Due to the extremely short time remaining prior to the Senator's departure, we must have these lists faxed to our office NLT 003 Thursday, May 6, 1993
