

The following response is provided to question # 2 to Mr. Bell by Senator McCain.

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A. The SRV should make available for interview current and former cadre who were involved in the detention, evacuation and medical treatment of US POWs. Although the Vietnamese have indicated that cadre were only peripherally involved, they should nevertheless be considered as potential witnesses due to their knowledge of policy matters, as well as the identities and current whereabouts of their former subordinates who were directly involved with US POWs. 2. Other areas in which the Vietnamese can be cooperative are:
 - A. Enabling completely free investigation activity by our Live Sighting Investigator.
 - B. Assistance in finding an attractive, large and permanent facility free of any other DOD mission.
 - C. Access to copies of wartime records.
 - D. Assistance in effecting ease of transportation (a helicopter area) and communication (in-country radio comm) with the province counterparts.
 - E. Improving Hanoi liaison and communication with the counterparts.
 - F. Signing the joint agreement for establishing the office which will afford access to the office's two vehicles (currently impounded).

3. Question number 17 posed to Mr. Bell by Senator Reid concerning Americans held with Eric G. Garwood cannot be answered with the limited information available here in the Hanoi Office. This question was well covered however, in the detailed report titled "Investigation of the MR5 Camp for US POWs", which was published in conjunction with joint investigation iteration 11 in Quang Nam-Da nang Province in August 1990.
