

1. A/C attacked by MIG ~~100~~ while flying from the south.
2. Stream running west to east downhill where body of one crewmember said to have been found two days after crash ~~at~~ north of the road and carried across and downhill from the road to where body was buried in a streambed. Body later washed away when bank eroded during heavy rains.
3. Area where tail said to have separated from aircraft and 3 crewmembers fell out. 1 chute opened but man died due to burns the following day.
4. Area where ~~100~~ 3 bodies found 2 days after crash and 2 more bodies 4 days after crash. 3 bodies buried in stream bank and washed away. 2 bodies recovered from grave on top hill in photo. Both of the bodies recovered were found 4 days after crash.
5. Area where nose section of A/C said to have fallen shortly after tail separated and when aircraft exploded in air over the river.
