HEARD FROM HUSBAND UNDERGOING REED IN HA SON BINH CAMP (ARVN LTC NGO HUY THANG) THAT U.S. HAD BEEN HELD THERE IN 1972-1973 AND SOME UNMARKED GRAVES THERE CONTAINED THEIR BODIES.

2. RP80-038 (POSS REFNO 9854 OR 0692)

IN 1966 SAW U.S. 105 A/C SHOT DOWN NEAR CA DUONG (V) THANK OAI (D) HA TAY (P). SAW NO PARACHUTES. (VIC WH69867). H

3. HK83-006 (PROBABLE 0885)

IN MID 1965 AT MIDDAY SAW A/C CRASH NEAR TAN VOC (V) (POSS WJ8402). PILOT CAPTURED AND TAKEN TO HA DONG (WJ8118). CAUCASIAN NOT INJURED BUT HEARD HE WAS BEATEN BY VILLAGERS AND LATER DIED.

4. T83-037

IN DECEMBER 1972, B-52 CRASHED INFIELD NEAR TAY QUA HAMLET, MINH SINH VILLAGE, THANH OAI DIST. ALLEGEDLY TWO PILOTS WERE STILL INSIDE.
