My father is so old, my mummy also old, could not do any heavy work, <sup>to take their flying</sup> and I am the only son in the family. <sup>who support them.</sup> But I always inform me every time your letter reached him.

I have checked around with the local authority, for my migrant to the United States but it seems they are not willing to allow me to leave. Maybe because I don't have any "Đông" to offer them. They kept my "Giấy ra hai" and I have asked them several time to give it back to me.

and they haven't said anything <sup>and some parts of the world</sup>

In the United States I know a number old friends of mine such as Bill Erdhol, working with US Embassy in Paris - France and Bert F. English working with US Embassy in Tokyo - Japan, via David Devin's letter last year, he told me that they all indicated their willingness to help me, and they are forming a group effort to help me. My present problem is I could not afford to pay the expense to work out on application. If I could have some about US\$1000, <sup>or more</sup> I think I will be able to get ~~through~~ through with all the difficulties.

I would appreciate very much if you could convince any friend to give me a hand, especially if you could contact with Lanley North Carolina try to locate Stu Hethven and Bryan Mills my former boss (CAB) tell them to rescue me out of this mess.

Another thing as Y. Jui has advised me try to help the young highlanders to go to the United States for various field training, such as Medical doctor education and so on. and here I have Y. Krei Knul (now is a doctor) and here is his background:

In 1967 he was enlisted by USSF as Mike Force Soldier with 'C' team in Pleiku.


Period 1967. 1969 he was enlisted by USSF. Stude for work at Buon Dong BAK USSF Camp.
