b. The three principal sub-sections of the Provincial Section were as follows:

(1) Propaganda: The Propaganda Sub-section had the mission to study documents, print propaganda leaflets and indoctrinate the inhabitants residing in the VC controlled areas.

(2) Penetration (Fifth Column) Sub-section: Organization and cadre members were unknown.

(3) POW and Falliers' Affairs Sub-section: The chief of this sub-section was Nguyen NAM. The section was responsible for the VC POW camps and was divided into the following two categories:

(a) Mobile POW Camps: These camps were usually maintained near areas of anticipated hostile action in order to quickly receive, classify and move POW's and Falliers to permanent prison camps in the VC Secret Zone, exact location unknown.

(b) POW Camps in the VC Secret Zone: These camps were built in the secure areas of the VC Secret Zone in order to detain and indoctrinate POW's. The personnel of one such POW camp were as follows: Nguyen DAO, Director; Le Ba CUONG, Assistant; Vo Xuan CHI (arrested), Adjutant; BINH, Medic and BINH, HOANG, THANH and HANH, guards. ~~These camps were built in the dense jungle area of the VC Secret Zone at PS 910, 910 approximately 10 miles south of Ba Mountain (BS-0407910).~~ The camp facilities were as follows: two barracks for prisoners with a capacity of approximately 50 persons in each barrack, one kitchen for prisoners, one barrack for the guards, one meeting house, one kitchen for the cadre and one house for the cadre.

c. The cadres of Headquarters, Provincial Military Proselyting Section of Quang Tin Province at one time lived in the houses of the inhabitants of the 2nd Hamlet, Ky Long Village, Tam Ky District, Quang Tin Province. When the section headquarters moved to Phuoc Cam Village in August 1966 the VC cadre members moved into the homes of the people in that village.

d. The training course for the military proselyting cadre members of Binh Giang Village was held in four huts located on a mountain slope in Lang Nga Village (BT 064 278). The training course had the mission to train and indoctrinate the cadres in the political policy of the NFLSWM. The course duration was two months. Organization of the course was as follows:

(1) Director: Nguyen THONG, Secretary of Thanh Binh District Committee.

(2) Lecturers: Nguyen Tan LIEU and Nguyen BINH, both military proselyting cadre members of Thanh Binh District Committee.

(3) Students: There were 25 students divided into three cells as follows:
