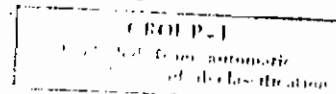

06-2030-07 (23 page original, handwritten.) (A)	Bio-Data of A US POW Item #1: Letter, dated 27 Jun 67, signed by T. THANG for T.618, requests the Guerrilla Cell of Son Dong Vill, [Son Tinh Dist, Quang Ngai Prov], to evacuate a US POW, who was captured by Son Tinh and Binh Son Dist's, to T.12 POW Camp in the night of 27 Jun 67. Following is the bio-data of this man: - Name : BON [Possibly Vietnamese phonetic of Paul] - Date enlisted: 3 Apr 62 - Unit : US Marine Div in Chu Lai - Rank : Cpl - Position : Sqd Ldr - Serial No : 1996608 - Date entered RVN: Nov 65 - Battles fought: Seven - Date captured: 24 [Jun 67] - Marital status: Single - Brother : Two - Sister : One Item #2: Letter #01/VP, dated 15 Jul 67, signed by NGUYEN KIM DUNG for T.618, introduces HO NGOC CHUONG, a cadre of T.12, to Unit V.409. HO NGOC CHUONG was in charge of evacuating BON, a US POW, to Z POW Camp. Item #3: Notebook with entries dated from Jan to Jul 67, prepared by U/I member [of T12 POW Camp], reveals the following: The allowances granted to Allied POW's [other than RVNAP] consisted of 21 Kgs of husked rice, 240\$00 for food, 15\$00 for cigarettes and 30\$00 for other necessities, per month, and two sets of local pyjamas and two sets of underwear [a year], and a Western white suit on their release. Cash entries indicate that 11,622\$00 was spent on food and med supplies in Jan, 11,854\$00 in Feb, 12,537\$00 in Mar, 10,444\$00 in Apr, 10,472\$00 in May, 10,628\$00 in Jun, and 13,259\$00 in Jul 67. BON, [Rank] an American prisoner, received one set of clothing and a towel on 28 Jun and on 8 Jul 67. 08-2093-67* (5 page original, handwritten.) (1)	VC POW Camp, Quảng Ngãi Prov., MR V. Item #1: Roster, undated, lists bio-data of 12 members of Camp 12 [VC POW Camp in Quảng Ngãi Prov]. All the members are natives of Bình Sơn, Sơn Tinh and Mộ Đức Dist, Quảng Ngãi Prov. Item #2: Roster, dated 27 Mar 67, signed by THAI XUAN HONG for Camp 18 Management Committee, lists names of six prisoners of Camp 18, who were to be transferred to Camp 12. The prisoners who are RVN Popular Force of 81st, 83d, 79th, and 98th Plat, were taken prisoner [by VC] in An Sơn, Nghĩa Hành Dist [Quảng Ngãi Prov] on 4 Mar 67. Item #3: Receipt, #2, dated 24 Feb 67, signed by KIM DANG of T12 [VC] POW Camp, reveals that four prisoners who are RVNAF Pvt's were handed over from DANG to THU. The latter is a member of Camp T25. Item #4: Report, dated 14 Jul 67, signed by VO TRUNG TAM of Armed Security Unit, countersigned by TAN, Chief T12 Camp, reveals that, in compliance with the decision of T604 dated Apr 67, and by order of T608 and T618-75, beginning from 15 Jul 67, the responsibility of handling 22 prisoners, including one American, will be handed over from Armed Security Unit to Camp T12. The report further discloses that Armed Security Unit returned four rifles and one K50 SMG with 84 rounds of ammunition to T12 on 27 Apr 67.
