Dear Sir,

About five months ago I send a letter to you in which there were pictures of mine, and of my relatives. The letter was sent to the address of the ODP programme in Thailand. I have not received any responses to my letter. It is therefore I send this by means of my friend in Canada in hope that you will response me.

In 1968 I enlisted in the Army of the Republic Vietnam. In 1970 I was sent to enroll in the Non-Commissioned Officer Programme at Dong-De, the code was 9/70A, Battion Tran Hung Dao, its leader was Major General Linh Quan Vien KBC 4311. I was awarded Sergeant, and in 1972 I was transferred to the Main Force Division 3/56, my sercive number was 71/137-836, my leader was General Bui Van Giai. During my years in the Army, my responsibilities were to spy at the mountain of the district Son My near the sea Ba Tan Giang, province Quang Ngai. My group found a corpse of an American soldier wearing a shoulder sleeve insignia of an Eagle with the words Airbon. Because of our assigment, and the unsafety at that time, we buried the soldier at the mountain of Ba Tan Giang. I was in Army until 1975, and in December 30th, 1975 I was sent to the Re-Education Camp by the new Government to July of 1983. By means of international broadcast I acknowledge the American clemency, and its Government is willing to sponsor the former soldiers of its ally, as well as anyone who is willing to help the American Government to look for the dead bodies of American soldiers killed in battle in Vietnam.

With the above information, I temparariously write this letter to you. Would you please hand over this to the President of the programme responsible for looking the dead

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bodies of the American soldiers in Vietnam, along with my aspirations as follows :

- I am willing to help the American Government to look for the corpse that I mentioned above.

- I would like to have nothing but myself and my relatives being sponsored to any Western Countries.
