

Information: Source claimed to have a friend named Vuong My who resides at: 120 Lo Y, Ngo Gia Tu, F10, Q3, HCM City. According to Source, My presently has the remains of two American servicemen hidden in a refrigerator in his home. In addition to these skeletal remains, My allegedly has the corresponding dog tag for one, and half a dog tag (broken) of the other. One of the remains supposedly came from Tay Ninh Province, while the other originated in Pleiku.

Source did not know anything about the two Americans, or who they were. He personally saw the remains, and said the bones were "very long". Asked if the remains included skulls, Source claimed he did not notice since he was generally fearful of remains. For this same reason, Source refused to carry out some teeth from the remains when My asked Source to do so upon his departure from Vietnam. Source says he viewed the one dog tag and the broken half of another but, as he can only read Chinese, he did not understand what was written on the dog tags. (Note: Source could not describe either the size, shape, or material of the dog tags.)

In addition to his possession of the two remains, Source stated that My claimed knowledge (NFI) of five other U.S. remains.

Source said that My intends to depart Vietnam by boat, and had said he had intended to bring the two remains with him. However, just prior to Source's departure from Vietnam, a third person had offered to buy the remains for three luong (taels) of gold each. My told Source he might sell one of the two, but Source is not sure of the final outcome of this transaction.

Comment: After initially providing an outline of his POW/MIA knowledgeability, Source demanded (belligerently) that interviewer intercede to permit Source to travel directly to the U.S. rather than to the Philippines. Though interviewer explained why he could not do so, Source persisted in this demand and refused to divulge additional details. Only after interviewer put away his papers and closed his briefcase to depart did Source grudgingly provide the above information.
