2. INCIDENT SUMMARY. SOURCE PROVIDES HEARSAY
INFORMATION CONCERNING THE SRV CONFINEMENT OF CAUCASIAN
PRISONERS-OF-WAR WHO ARE ALLEGEDLY STILL HELD IN THE
MOUNTAINOUS AREAS OF BA VI (VIC WJ 3828) AND TAM DAO
(VIC WJ 6772).

3. INFORMATION. THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION WAS
RELATED BY SOURCE TO INTERVIEWER AS FACT. AT APPROX 0800
HOURS ON A DAY IN DEC 1975 (DAY NOT RECALLED), SOURCE WAS
HELD IN THE LONG KHANH RE-EDUCATION CAMP WHICH WAS LOCATE
APPROX 500 METERS FROM THE XUAN LOC AIRFIELD, NEAR THE
FORMER ARVN 18TH INFANTRY DIVISION DISPENSARY. ON THAT
DAY, A COMMUNIST 1LT WHO WORKED AS THE CAMP "TRAINING"
OFFICER, DURING A "TRAINING" SESSION TOLD THE INMATES
"YOU INMATES ARE LUCKY TO BE RE-EDUCATED AT LONG KHANH,
AS A NUMBER OF CAUCASIAN PRISONERS-OF-WAR WHO CARRIED ARM
AND MURDERED VIETNAMESE PEOPLE ARE STILL CURRENTLY HELD
IN RE-EDUCATION IN THE MOUNTAINOUS AREAS OF BA VI AND TAM
DAO, NORTHERN VIETNAM". NO FURTHER DETAILS OR REFERENCE
TO CAUCASIAN PRISONERS WAS MADE TO SOURCE OR THE INMATES.
SOURCE STATED THE INMATES DID NOT BELIEVE WHAT THE CADRE
HAD TOLD THEM CONCERNING THE CAUCASIANS.

4. SOURCE RECALLED THE LBN OF THE LONG KHANH RE-ED
CAMP WAS EITHER L9T5 OR L19T5. SOURCE WAS HELD IN THE
CAMP FROM SEP 1975 UNTIL THE EXPLOSION OF THE AMMUNITION
BUNKER. SOURCE WAS WOUNDED IN THE EXPLOSION. TWO DAYS
AFTER THE EXPLOSION, ALL INMATES IN THE CAMP WERE MOVED
TO LONG GIAO RE-ED CAMP. SOURCE RECALLED THAT THERE
WERE APPROX 2,500 INMATES IN THE LONG KHANH CAMP, ALMOST
ALL OF WHOM WERE FORMER GVN COMPANY GRADE OFFICERS. IN
LONG GIAO, SOURCE WAS HELD IN THE AREA NEXT TO THE HIGH-
WAY, PRESUMABLY IN T11, T13 OR T14.

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
