

3. In January 1985 an acquaintance, Ut Minh of Phu Ngai Tri (V), Vam Co (D), Long An (P) related the following to source. Minh claimed to know the location of the graves of two U.S. servicemen. The Americans, both alleged to be advisors, one a caucasian Major and the other a black Sergeant, were killed by artillery fire near Bien Hoa and buried by Minh and other members of his reconnaissance unit. According to Minh the location of the graves is now a paramilitary camp and formerly the headquarters area of the 9th Regiment, 5th ARVN Division.

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4. Source provided a sketch of the area given to him by Minh. The crosses indicate the location of the graves. The circles indicate another possible location. (Source stated that Minh was unsure on which side of the water tower the graves were located.) The sketch is enclosed with this report.
