(B)	<p>(C) US Personnel Captured by the VC in CU CHI Area in Aug 68.</p> <p>(C) Report, dtd 5 Sep 68, prepared by N2/A.39, relates the exploitation of three US servicemen captured in an attack on a convoy on the route from Cu Chi to Tay Ninh on 25 Aug 68.</p> <p>The captives are Sgt K, Thomas and B. They were truck drivers of the US 48th Transportation Group stationed at Long Binh. B is a negro. Sgt K has served in a US Transportation Unit in West Germany.</p> <p>The captives express their opinion on many subjects, such as the VN war, the GVN, the US troop morale, their unit's strength and composition, the NFLSVN and the VC cause.</p> <p>(U) CDEC COMMENT: Full translation of document will follow under IRR #6 027 1232 68.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>W.
