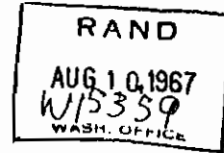

 - e. Synopsis: Ltr, No 469/33 dated 12 Sep 65 by Tú Thang for C289 / COSVN Security Section addressed to security section of Bình Dương Province concerns the proposed release and exploitation of Trần Bao Linh captured with her sister and an English man named Wallis on 14 Feb 65.
3. Date document received at Combined Document Exploitation Center (CDEC): 28 April 67.

All comrades are requested to assign cadre to work on this project from the date of Tran Bao Linh's release until the meeting and in interrogation. Report to An Nam Truong [Security section of Nam Truong] by radio, the time and place where Tran Bao Linh will meet our personnel.

[Page 2 of original text]

We should note the following points:

a) Do not let Tran Bao Linh know that she was arrested in the camp of R, in R base or even the local base.

b) Give her good treatment now as we'll as later on, when she returns here (Question her in a conversational manner not an interrogating manner) to leave impressions favorable to our plans.
