02-1389-66	<p>Directive.</p> <p>Directive No 13/BTC, dated 21 December 1965 and signed by Le Huan, Chief of "Yellow Star" B, Organization Section, addressed to all units, requesting establishment of the dead's records with complete details of the location of the dead's grave, full names, birth place, personal effects and address of the dead's family to facilitate recognition in the future.</p> <p>One of these copies should be kept in the unit's file and one sent to "Yellow Star" Organization Section together with the four following types of paper to prevent missing locations of the dead's grave:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1- One death certificate.2- One letter of condolence to the dead's family.3- One sketch of the dead's grave with adequate notes.4- The dead's personal effects as souvenirs (if there is any) <p>All " worksites " are requested to prepare the above papers before reporting cases of death to his Province military unit such as Quang Nam, Quang Ngai, Binh Dinh, Phu Yen Province and his family. As regards those coming from distant provinces such as Quang Tri, Thua Thien and from North Vietnam or Nambo Region 6, they should be sent to " Yellow Star " along with the four types of paper plus 2 following reports for transfer to their families concerned.</p>	<p>12 Feb 1966 BR704817, 1st US Air C/v.
