02-1382-66	<p>- Nguyen Van Ut (Le), province staff cadre.</p> <p>- Nguyen Huu Phuoc (Phuc), Province Staff Assistant for Corbat Affairs.</p> <p>[No Further Exploitable Information]</p> <p>Report.</p> <p>Report dated 19 January 1966 from Cao Van Long, LBN 1912 "640", to Anh Hai, LBN 29/4200A [Military Resupplying Section of Eastern Nambo Region], containing the following information:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- There is a considerable delay in communication and liaison. 2- Enemy forces have stepped up artillery action and sweep operations. 3- In a month, enemy ambushes levied a toll of eight cadre and over a squad of soldiers killed. In return, guerrillas inflicted heavy losses upon the enemy. 4- Enemy forces sank the " Thuan Phong " boat on the Saigon - Dau Tieng river section, killing more than 200 civilians and 70 dependents of enlisted men and officers of the RVNAF 5th Infantry Division, the 8th Infantry Regiment and the Regional Forces. Soldiers whose dependents were killed are planning on shooting the Americans and joining the revolutionary forces. American officials have come down to investigate the case and advanced 1,500 VN \$ to each family for burial expenses. 5- 270 puppet soldiers were sent to reinforce the garrison at Tan Quy but about 200 of them deserted en route. 6- Two civilians from Saigon reported that the cost of living there has considerably increased.
