(C-Sep 72) Item 1: (8 pages, typewritten; B-3) Activity plan, dated 16 Mar 72, signed by Viet Anh for K21 and K33 ((possibly agencies of the Binh Son District Party Committee, Quang Ngai Province, VC Region 5)), pertains to military proselyting activities to be conducted from now ((16 Mar 72)) to Jul 72.

The document provides an assessment of the future situation of the enemy ((RVNAF)) after the withdrawal of the US troops, and states that the opportunity will arise to step up military proselyting activities.

To attack the enemy politically, subordinate cadre and Party members were to participate in a military proselyting front to popularize the ten points of the new military proselyting policy. ((RVNAF)) troop dependents were to be motivated to cooperate in political struggles and military actions. Every effort was to be made to disrupt the ((RVN)) People's Self-Defense Force organization. ((RVNAF)) regular and Regional Force elements should be incited to disobey orders and stage armed revolts. Recruitment of revolutionary agents was to be intensified in enemy units, and military proselyting machinery should be strengthened together with the intensification of propaganda activities.

To strengthen the military proselyting organization, the ((Binh Son)) District ((Party Committee)) was to activate a propaganda unit of three members, and each village was to activate one legal ((having RVN legal status)) propaganda cell and one megaphone cell. On 15 Apr ((72)), the classification of the ((RVNAF)) troops dependents into categories and the recruitment of military proselyting personnel should be completed.

By the end of May 72, the district was to recruit 7 to 9 military proselyting cadre and 18 legal ((military proselyting)) agents. Each village was to recruit three to five cadre, and each hamlet was to recruit five cadre. Sixty fifth columnists were to be planted in ((RVNAF)) Regional Force elements, and 100 fifth columnists were to be planted in ((RVNAF)) Popular Force elements.

To meet the military proselyting criteria, a meeting was to be held on an unstated date by the ((Binh Son)) District ((Party Committee)) to discuss



forthcoming military proselyting training courses to be conducted on a large scale for all armed units, popular associations, villages, and agencies. Intensification of propaganda activities in enemy units and establishment of a PW detention camp in ((Binh Soh)) District would also be discussed.

(C-Sep 72) Item 2: (1 page, handwritten; B-3) Activity plan, dated 17 Mar 72, signed by Ngoc of the Military Proselyting Section, Binh Thuân Village ((Party Committee, Binh Sơn District, Quang Ngai Province, VC Region 5)), pertains to military proselyting activities to be conducted during Phases 1 (from Jan to Mar 72) and 2 (from the beginning of Apr to the end of May 72).

The document also deals with dissemination of the new military proselyting policy, establishment of fifth columnist and military proselyting organizations, intensification of propaganda activities, and development of military proselyting personnel.
