(C-Jul 72) Item 1: (1 page, typewritten; B-3) Circular, with ((VC)) Urgent precedence, dated 27 Apr 72, signed by Minh Chau for Vu Nam ((possibly the Military Proselyting Section, VC Daklak Province Party Committee, B3 Front)), addressed to the Military Proselyting Sections of subordinate districts, instructs them to submit reports containing the following information to Vu Nam:

The number of mass uprisings and armed revolts inside enemy ((RVNAF)) ranks since the beginning ((of the current VC/NVA Offensive));

The number of PWs captured in recent battles and the number of enemy deserters and defectors in each district;

The number of ((VC)) fifth columnists currently operating in enemy units, and the names of all enemy officers in each district.

Henceforth, the Current Affairs Party Committee of each district was empowered to decide as to whether any captured or defected ((RVN)) Combat Youth or People's Self Defense Force members should be recruited ((into VC ranks)). Similarly, the Current Affairs Party Committee of the ((VC Daklak)) Province was empowered to decide whether to recruit captured or defected ((RVNAF)) regular, Regional, and Popular Forces members. All captured enemy officers should be evacuated to the province's nearest ((PW)) camp.

(C-Nov 72) Item 2: (57 pages, handwritten; B-3) Notebook, with entries dated between 13 Jan and 24 May 72, maintained by an unidentified member of an unspecified agency ((possibly a district military proselyting section, VC Daklak Province Party Committee, B3 Front)), contains minutes of meetings ((12 pages)), political reorientation notes ((21 pages)), resolutions ((5 pages)), political struggle plans ((17 pages)), and financial notes ((2 pages)).

It was noted that between 25 and 28 May 72, 750 propaganda leaflets were disseminated by military proselyting elements throughout the district. These consisted of 250 propaganda leaflets disseminated by K1 ((Area 1)), 250 by K2

((Area 2)), and 250 by K3 ((Area 3)). On 29 Apr 72, military proselyting elements in K3 handed out 18 news bulletins, sent 36 proselyting letters ((to RVNAF personnel)), and conducted three propaganda sessions using loudspeakers. On 6 May 72, 100 propaganda leaflets were disseminated by K6 ((Area 6)).

An undated entry indicates that two ((military proselyting)) olimaxing phases were to be conducted by the district. Phase 1 was to occur between 24 Apr and 1 May 72; and Phase 2, between 25 and 27 May 72. During these phases, the criteria to be fulfilled by military proselyting elements were to indoctrinate all of the ((RVN)) People's Self Defense Force personnel's relatives and 70 to 80% of all of the ((RVNAF)) Regional Force personnel's relatives.

On 30 Apr 72, friendly ((VC/NVA)) elements attacked the B. Reh Bridge with three B-40 rounds, three B-41 rounds, and two mines. On the same day, the author contacted four ((possibly VC underground agents)) of X1, including an ((RVNAF)) Popular Force platoon leader.

An entry, dated 13 May 72, states that, in accordance with higher echelon's instructions, the district was to draft 15 to 30 male youths and 16 to 25 female youths into the ((VC)) Army. In addition, 15 to 20% of all enemy servicemen within the district should be caused to desert or defect through enemy proselyting techniques. It was further indicated that a military proselyting campaign was to be launched within the district. The campaign was to begin on 19 May and end on 22 Dec ((72)).

An entry, dated 15 May 72 indicates that during the forthcoming months, K1 was to activate one military proselyting cell; K3, two cells; K6, one ((RVN)) legal ((status)) cell; and 7A one two-member underground cell.
