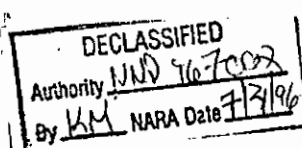

01-1200-66	<p>Memorandum</p> <p>Memorandum #67/VP, dated 13 July 1965, signed by Ngo Hien, for Lau Kim Agency, to various District and Village Military Proselyting Sections initiating a campaign against the US in 3 phases from 13 to 20 July 1965, from 20 July 65 to 19 August 65, from 19 August 65 to 2 September 65, as ordered by Cau Long Current affairs Committee.</p> <p>This campaign consisted essentially of personnel-like broadcasts directed to KVNAF, telling them of US soldiers' crimes against RVNAF soldiers' dependents at home.</p> <p>[No further exploitable information]</p>	<p>11 Dec 65, BTO64297, III MAF. 01-1201-66	<p>Military Proselyting Training Pamphlet</p> <p>Incomplete VC secret Military Proselyting Training Pamphlet, date and originating agency missing, covering experiences gained in political attacks against:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - An enemy unit engaged in a pacification mission. - An enemy Regular Force Battalion in the occasion of the Lunar New Year. - An enemy military installation. <p><u>In Political attack on an enemy unit engaged in a pacification mission:</u></p> <p>In Sep 64, the enemy 2d Marine Battalion was sent to L.T. to support the establishment of Strategic Hamlets in that area.</p> <p>Isolated contacts were made first to determine the morale of the unit, followed by probationary political attacks. Later, a big demonstration was staged with the participation of enemy soldiers' dependents. 	<p>5th Division in T Village.</p> <p>A few trusty enemy soldiers' dependents were sent out to individually contact soldiers asking them whether they would have a leave on the occasion of the coming Lunar New Year since the Front had proclaimed a ceasefire. Upon favorable reaction, leaflets were disseminated to them, and some POW were released in the area. People kept asking and induced enemy soldiers to go home during the Lunar New Year. The Military Proselyting recruited 15 enemy soldiers to work as our agents and more than a hundred other enemy soldiers deserted. The enemy was obliged to relieve this Battalion in April 1964.</p> <p><u>In a political attack against an enemy military base:</u></p> <p>In this base, the enemy soldiers were not allowed to meet their families. On 14 Aug 64, over 50 enemy soldiers' dependents were invited by our agents to come and stay in their house, then were propagandized into inducing their husbands or sons to desert. Then our agents, working as farmers plowing their fields near the training area, told the soldiers that their families were waiting outside and arranged a meeting. Then the soldiers, upon encouragement from their families, would desert. In 5 days, 126 enemy troops were AWOL.</p> <p>[No further exploitable information]</p>	
01-1202-66	<p>VC Communiqué</p> <p>Communiqué, Numbered 143/CT, dated 8 Nov 65, from Unit 107 to Village Committees, Village Unit Headquarters and "C" Commanders, informing them of the reassignment of the following personnel:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tran Thuy, formerly Operations Training Cadre, is reassigned as Assistant District Unit Leader to Unit 107. - Truong Cong Thai, formerly Operations Training Cadre, is reassigned to replace Bin Phu Bong. <p>This reassignment is effective on 1 Nov 65.</p> <p>The Communiqué is signed by Vu Quan Thieu, Staff Assistant for Political Affairs. 	<p>military intelligence cell at each village.</p> <p>This military intelligence cell will be led by the Deputy Village Unit Headquarters and consist of all hamlet unit leaders or assistant hamlet unit leaders and the leader of the village concentrated guerrilla platoon. It will receive support from the people's military intelligence network and guidance from the Village [Party] Committee. Nevertheless, it is still under direct control of Village Unit Command Committee.</p> <p>Military intelligence reports will be channelled from hamlet to village then to district.</p> <p><u>USMACV/DEC COMMENT:</u></p> <p>Phi Truong K51 is possibly Thang Binh District Military Affairs Committee (Quang Tin Province).</p> <p>[No further exploitable information]</p>	
01-1204-66	<p>VC Communique</p> <p>Un-numbered Communique, dated 15 Jun 65, from TAM, Chief of B.104 to B.201, F11, and Village Units, urging these units to carry on and increase sabotage activities on Highway*. Past sabotage actions on this highway succeeded in isolating a number of enemy areas along the highway.</p> <p><u>USMACV DEC COMMENTS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - B104 is possibly Cuurent Affairs Committee of Thang Binh District [Party] Committee, Quang Tin Province. - B201, F111 and F115 are probably Thang Binh District Local Units. - * Possibly Highway # 1. <p>[No further exploitable information]</p>	<p>13 Dec 65, BT125276, III MAF Received DEC: 8 Jan 66.</p>
01-1205-66	<p>VC Communique</p> <p>Un-numbered Communique, dated 10 August 1965, from Phi Truong K51 to his Village Committee* and Village Unit Headquarters, announcing that a new position: Staff Assistant for Women Affairs has been created to enlist the service of women. All villages are required to submit to the Staff Assistant for Women Affairs a listing of women serving in guerrilla-militia units, female teenagers and suspicious women.</p> <p>The Communique was signed by Vu Quang Thieu, Staff Assistant for Political Affairs for the Commander of Phi Truong K51.</p> <p><u>USMACV DEC COMMENTS:</u></p> <p>Phi Truong K.51 is possibly Thang Binh District Military Affairs Committee.</p>	<p>13 Dec 65, BT125276, III MAF. 01-1206-66	<p>* Probably Village Autonomous Committee.</p> <p>[No further exploitable information]</p> <p>VC Political Indoctrination Documents</p> <p>Undated VC Political Indoctrination Document applicable to Vietnamese prisoners. The document consists of five (5) parts.</p> <p><u>Part 1</u>: Anti-US-Propaganda alleging that the United States is invading South Vietnam and that the RVN government is but traitorous lackeys of the United States.</p> <p><u>Part 2</u>: The SVN people, doggedly refused to act as slaves of the United States, are staging a national salvation resistance to restore peace, independence, democracy and neutrality to South Vietnam.</p> <p><u>Part 3</u>: Policies and guidelines of the National Front for the Liberation of South Vietnam.</p> <p><u>Part 4</u>: The RVNAF is an instrument utilized by the United States to repress the SVN people. As a result, it is a crime against the SVN people to serve in RVNAF.
