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Our recent release of POW's and surrenderers has a very large impact. According to higher headquarters, we will badly need US POW's for use. In the battles, our armed and para-military forces must try to capture POW's from the US satellite forces, keep them carefully, observe, implement properly our POW policy, and evacuate them immediately to Military Proselyting agencies to use them in necessary missions.
