TO: Local areas ⁶ Villages
Subject: Handling of POWs

According to the policy of X.U., all POW camps at every Ps are abolished. To handle POWs effectively, BX6 has designated the following points:

If POWs are caught by village forces, village troop proselyting section should ask for advice of the Party Committee echelon and then arm village guerrillas to deliver them to POW Camp X. Rice for POWs will be supplied by District Finance - Economy Section which will settle the expenses with Finance - Economy Section X. Each POW is to be issued 500 grams of rice and 2 RVN \$ per day from Village Finance - Economy Section. This expense will be settled with District Finance - Economy Section.

Each guerrilla cadre in charge of handling of POWs will be issued 4 RVN piasters and 500 grams of rice. This expense will be provided out of the village funds. In case these are not sufficient funds in the District Finance - Economy Section, the expense will be settled by BX6.

POWs who are captured while attacking main objectives will be handled by the element of BX6 in coordination with troop proselyting section of P. Local guerrillas are in charge of handling of POWs captured in local areas. Before handling POWs cadre in charge must explain the policy of the Front to the POWs, make out a POW list and write a letter of introduction from the local agency.

POW delivering points: POWs captured from villages South of Phú Mỹ are to be delivered to Mr. Liêm at Thuận Phong Hamlet, Cát Hiệp, Phú Cát District; POWs caught at villages North of Phú Mỹ are to be delivered to Mr. Tuấn at Nghĩa Điền Hamlet, An Nghĩa Village, Hoài An District and from here they will be received by designated cadre in charge of POWs.

In local areas, troop proselyting section, guerrillas and village Finance Economy Sections should have plans for the handling of POWs. They should use the policies of the Front as a guide for handling POWs.
